

HI Y'all

Here it is - the list of the good doers that we managed to dig up this year before it turned too hot. I had hoped to have a wider selection of divisions and a few more historic, but this is what got turned up. All these bulbs have been down in Alabama soil for at least 6 years...some much longer than that. Most were starts from only one or two bulbs originally planted, so of course, since I managed enough bulbs to offer them for sale, that's an indication that they are good doers here!

This is an AUTUMN BULB SALE LIST. It's a one-time deal. These bulbs are already dug up and curing in the shed as we speak. They all looked great - if they didn't look great, I didn't put them in the list.

This is the best selection of trumpets I am probably going to have for a long time as this is the stock where most of my collection entries came from. I don't know how many 2y-r's you can use, but I don't win the red-cupped collections most years by accident. You may see a few names that surprise you as growing well down here though. They certainly surprised me. You won't see any poets on here because I didn't dig any. If it's not on this list - well, maybe next year.

You know I don't believe in paying a bunch of money for daffodil bulbs, so you might be puzzled at my pricing system. Daffs are usually all worth about the same to me by this time. It's based on several factors: 1) Simplicity - I just don't have the time or the round tuit to make a bunch of different prices. 2) Quantity- if there are 50 bulbs in the sack when I planted two the first time, they are \$3. I think you can depend on these to multiply. If I have 5 bulbs left, you are paying more since I don't want to have to make a lot of substitutions when things run out. 3) Greed - We really liked them and wanted to keep them for ourselves - they may or may not be show flowers, but I will be glad to plant them back if you don't want 'em. 4) Availability- I am not seeing most of these bulbs in other lists or catalogues, so I'm not sure how hard some of them are to find. Remember that you are not paying to have them shipped from overseas. I've had some of them so long, I don't remember where I got them, but most of the places I bought daffodils are out of business now.

I sure wish I'd had this back when I bought a lot of daffodil bulbs! It's absolutely the best thing since sliced bread. But you know that your daffodils will probably look better than a lot of these photos. Since the pics are taken after the shows are judged, a lot of things aren't looking their best in there.

The Heart of Dixie bulbs are \$25 to everyone. I have a very limited number of these and I don't plan to dig them again for a long time.

Heart of Dixie 2w-yyo (Bit O'Gold OP) Weldon Childers, 1999. A very late division two - usually blooms in mid-April here in Alabama, so is very noticeable in the garden blooming by itself and a fabulous daffodil to pick. The white perianth has a beautiful shape but a gritty rough texture, so the lateness of this rimmed long-cup is probably it's best show asset. I don't have any photos, but it has a ruffled cup that is a lot like Bit O'Gold but much flatter and prettier. The only thing I can compare it to is a begonia I saw once called a picotee. This thing is sort of like a ghost or a witch - the photos never do come out. Large bulbs that I've had down for 5 years. \$25 each.

I don't have any of the other daffs that Weldon already registered, as he donated all those to different groups he belonged to, not daffodil society people. I do have a few seedlings that Weldon put names on that he never did register. I will be keeping an eye on those next year to hopefully get some registered and out to different people for growing on.

TERMS OF SALE

WHAT'S FOR SALE- All bulbs are subject to crop remaining after storage over the next two months-which should be all of them as we are having a long hot summer and I don't expect them to get any fungus or other conditions that would cause them to rot. These bulbs have already been inspected by me...which is how I arrived at the list. These bulbs are not treated with any chemicals and I did not wash them off with water. I did have to put a soaker hose down to get it moist enough to dig, so they didn't have a lot of soil clinging on there. I will hand rub each one especially for you when I put it in your box! There's no charge for the cat hair-even though this year you may get up to four different varieties! There may also be hair of the white dog.

HOW THEY GO - All bulbs are sold on a first come, first serve basis and orders will be strictly executed in the order they are received with payment. Please send me your order with payment before August 12, 2006, although I don't expect to have much left by then. I sack the bulbs in the order you paid, so if your order gets here first, you get the biggest bulbs. Please don't be e-mailing me to save things for you. You ARE WELCOME to let me know when you want me to mail your bulbs - or when you don't - I plan to get this done early this year.

NO LIMITS-There is no limit on the number of bulbs you can order of one kind, but BE SURE to make a list of substitutes you will accept. This is a one-time bulb sale of these varieties so I don't generally plan to do refunds. You may have learned from previous experience with me though, that, if you don't include an adequate list of substitutes with your order, and then you go and order a bunch of things I am out of, I will send all of your money back and you won't get any daffodils. I can't be making decisions for you.

THERE IS NO ORDER FORM - You can use the list enclosed and mark or highlight the cultivars you're ordering - just be sure to mark on the left side next to the name how many of each you are wanting. You can mark your substitutes on the right hand side. Please keep a copy for your own records. You will get your original order form back in your box with any necessary notations. I may or not keep a copy of your order for future reference, so you may want to keep up with that too for when things start blooming next spring. This worked great for me in the past, so there's no use to make more work for myself.

HOW TO PAY - Make checks or money orders payable to SANDRA STEWART and send it with your order to me at 1149 WELLS LOOP, JASPER AL 35503-3949.

SHIPPING - Please include \$7 postage for all orders, which will be shipped USPS Priority Mail in a new box. The Post Office promises 3-day delivery on these, so this is a real deal if you're ordering a large quantity since I will eat the extra - buddy up with your friends to save on shipping if you like. I cannot be responsible for packages lost or damaged during transit...so if you want insurance, please add an additional \$3.00 for every \$50 order.

RETURNS-Please look your order over as soon as you receive it - if you get any bad bulbs, contact me within 10 days of your receipt with an explanation of the problem. If I goofed, you will get a replacement or a refund. You will not find any bulb flies in there because they don't come down here. But IF YOU DO, I will want you to mail the entire sack back to me so that I can see it for myself.
