2010 ADS Daffodil Convention in Murphys, California March 11-14, 2010

This coming Spring, the Northern California Daffodil Society and Ironstone Vineyards will co-host the 56th ADS Convention and National Show on March 11, 14, 2010, in the historic town of Murphys, California. Murphys is located in California's famous Mother Lode Country. Murphys is located in the Sierra Nevada foothills with a population of 3,000. The Convention will be at the Ironstone Vineyards using their business-convention modern facilities, located on a windy road a mile from downtown Murphys. Ironstone's founder, John Kautz, has had a lifelong passion for daffodils.

Ironstone Vineyards has tasteful architecture, beautifully maintained gardens, and a profusion of daffodils throughout its properties and along the road leading to the Vineyards facilities. Attendees will enjoy Ironstone's wine tasting room, view historic artifacts and gold-rush era museum collection, jewelry shops, and gift delicatessen, and an open air amphitheater.

The main focus of the Convention will be on International camaraderie. Anticipated conventioneers are expected from United Kingdom, Australia, New Zealand, Holland, Canada, Chile, Japan, and the USA.

Between hybridizers and growers, there is a good possibility this could be the largest display of miniature daffodils ever held at a show in the USA if not the world. There will also be a wide variety of Intermediates and Standard Daffodils. Bob Spotts will exhibit many of his green viridiflorus seedlings. California exhibitors, Kirby Fong, Steve Hampson, Melissa Reading and John Castor, Nancy Tackett and Ben Blake will be joined by other exhibitors from the Pacific, Southeast, and Southwest Regions of the USA. ADS Twelve (different) Miniatures by Hybridizer Award

Twelve diminutive cultivars/seedlings bred by the exhibitor, any division(s). All flowers must be considered appropriate for the ADS Approved Miniatures List for an award to be given. Winner to receive the ADS Ribbon for 12 Miniatures by Hybridizer.

ADS Six (different) Miniatures by Hybridizer Award

Six diminutive cultivars/seedlings bred by the exhibitor, any division(s). All flowers must be considered appropriate for the ADS Miniatures List for an award to be given. Winner to receive the ADS Ribbon for 6 Miniature by Hybridizer.

ADS Three (*different*) Miniatures by Hybridizer Award

Three diminutive cultivars/seedlings bred by the exhibitor, any division(s). All flowers must be considered appropriate for the ADS Approved List of Miniatures for an award to be given. Winner to receive the ADS Ribbon for 3 Miniatures by Hybridizer.

There were 5 successful Premier Miniature Collection of 24 shown in the Pacific Region during the 2009 Season. The only other Premier Collection was shown at the 2009 Chicago National Convention. The

winners were: Livermore, CA: Jon Kawaguchi; Murphys, CA: Harold Koopowitz and Marilynn Howe; Fortuna, Nancy Wilson; Lake Oswego and Amity, OR: Walter Blom.
