Water - Water - Water

As the summer winds down, pay attention to how much water your daffodil plantings are getting!

September - October - November

As the soil temperature begins to cool, your daffodil bulbs are starting to wake up under ground. They need water as they come out of dormancy! You cannot see it, but they are actively growing. New roots are developing, and late in the fall they will chemically change so that they can survive our winters.

So, whether you are planting new daffodils or not, *all* of your daffodil plantings need lots of moisture *every fall*. If Mother Nature doesn't do it for us, drag those hoses around and give your daffodils sustained drinks through out the fall.
