

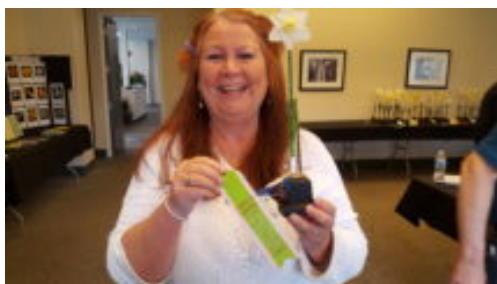
Columbus OH show
