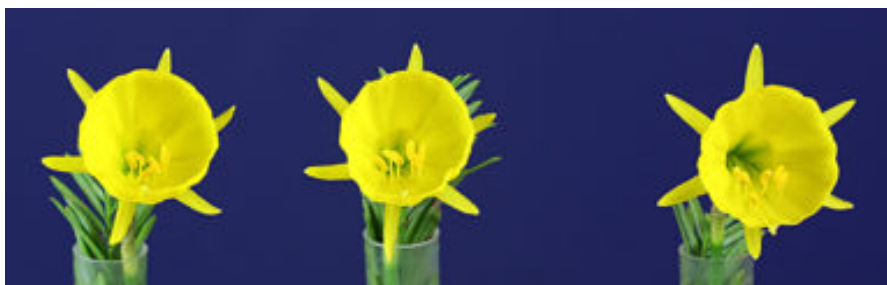

We finish the ADS awards at the 2018 Murphys show with the awards for miniature daffodils in show report order.



Mini Gold and Mini Rose Ribbons winner

The Miniature Gold Ribbon is for the best miniature in the show excluding the Container-Grown Section. The Miniature Rose Ribbon is for the best miniature seedling exhibited by its originator excluding the Container-Grown Section. Winner of both ribbons was seedling JBK 12-13-02 10G-Y ('Olumbo' x 'Kojak') exhibited by Jon Kawaguchi. Green was obviously the color of the day as the Gold and Rose Ribbon winner was also green.



Mini White Ribbon winner

The Miniature White Ribbon is for the best set of three miniatures in the show. Winner was JBK 07-15-03 10Y-Y (*N. bulb. var. tenuifolius* x *N. bulb. var. serotinus*) exhibited by Jon Kawaguchi.



Lavender Ribbon winner

The Lavender Ribbon is for the best collection of 5 miniature daffodils. Flowers in the winning exhibit are: 'Suzy Q' 10Y-Y, 'Zeekie' 2Y-Y, 'April' 12Y-Y, Keira KB-M-6Y-W-1-12 6Y-W, *N. cyclamineus* 13Y-Y. The exhibitor was Kirby Fong. For those of you searching DaffSeek for 'April,' you won't find it there. It's an unregistered miniature by Colin Crotty.



Bankhead Ribbon winner

The Bankhead Ribbon is for the best collection of 9 miniatures from at least 3 RHS divisions. Flowers in the winning exhibit are: Back row: JBK 10-05-09 10Y-Y (*N. bulb. var. tenuifolius* x 'Connie Greenfield'), 'Leota Mill' 2Y-YOO, 'Tete Boucle' 4Y-Y; Middle row: JBK 11-07-03 10Y-Y ('Landes' x 'Clay's Gold'), Keira KS-BH-283-03 10Y-Y, 'Tom Norman' 10Y-Y; Front row: JBK 06-36A-03 10Y-Y (Ta-Julia 4/92 x 'Treble Chance'), 'Englander' 6Y-Y, JBK 07-15-06 10Y-Y (*N. bulb. var. tenuifolius* x *N. bulb. var. serotinus*). Watrous Award winner

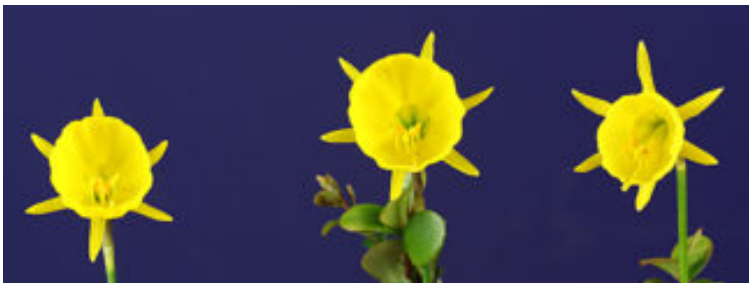

The flowers are: JBK 07-15-07 10Y-Y (*N. bulb. var. tenuifolius* x *N. bulb. var. serotinus*), JBK 07-15-05 10Y-Y (*N. bulb. var. tenuifolius* x *N. bulb. var. serotinus*), JBK 06-25-01 10Y-Y (*N. bulb. var. tenuifolius* x *N. bulb. var. serotinus*).

6 Minis by Hybridizer Ribbon winner

The Six Miniatures by Hybridizer Ribbon is for the best exhibit of six different cultivars hybridized and originated by the exhibitor. Jon Kawaguchi exhibited the winning exhibit. The flowers are: Back: JBK 10-05-05 10Y-Y (*N. bulb. var. filifolius* x 'Connie Greenfield'), JBK 12-14-09 10Y-Y (*N. bulb. var. tenuifolius* x *N. bulb. var. filifolius*), JBK 07-15-04 10Y-Y (*N. bulb. var. tenuifolius* x *N. bulb. var. filifolius*), Front: JBK 06-25-01 10Y-Y (*N. bulb. var. tenuifolius* x *N. bulb. var. serotinus*), JBK 10-05-03 10Y-Y (*N. bulb. var. filifolius* x 'Connie Greenfield'), JBK 06-36A-05 10Y-Y (Ta-Julia 4/92 x 'Treble Chance').
