INTRODUCTION

Welcome to my fifth catalogue.

I would like to thank my customers for their support in 2007 and hope your bulbs provide delight at flowering time.

Due to your continued support I have consolidated the daffodil side of the catalogue with many more newer top show varieties including a few from Jacksons of Australia. We have continued to list all of the recent releases from Clive Postles but for this year some will be in smaller quantities. This is down to his retirement and the small amount of stocks that were available to grow on. It is my intention to release his life time of work by supplying his remaining stocks of future seedlings as the stocks become large enough.

I am pleased to release the first real top show variety from Carlos van der Veeke called Touchdown which was named after Derek Bircumshaw's favourite sport. Derek was a great friend of the family and was given the privilege of growing it under a seedling number. Touchdown on its debut was included in Derek's winning Wootton Cup collection at the Daffodil Society 2005 show at Warwick and lots of interest was shown by many exhibitors including Roger.

Some of our daffodils increased more than expected mainly Altun Ha and Evesham and I have decided for one year only to offer them at a large reduction in price. Look in the catalogue for further details.

For miniature enthusiasts I hope to add to my already extensive range of varieties with one or two of the rarer varieties.

Most of the cultivars on offer are readily available but the most sought-after varieties are in short supply. To assist you I have indicated against these varieties the approximate amount available and these will be distributed on a first-come first-served basis.

I must apologise to my tulip customers who did not get what they ordered last year but due to circumstances beyond my control my suppliers had great difficulty with their stocks and were unable to supply to me.

This year I have been assured that these problems have been overcome and that the tulips listed are available. I believe that the current selection of Darwin and Late Single Tulips are the best Dutch exhibition varieties available at this time in the UK. I have also listed a wide selection of species tulipa, many of these are little gems and some are extremely rare.

For those interested in other miniature bulbs at reasonable prices, we have species Crocus, Alliums, Iris, Fritillaria, Ipheion and many more rare small flowering bulbs some of which are difficult to acquire.

As usual I intend to sell prepared and bedding Hyacinths, Imperialis Fritillaria, and bulbs for the greenhouse or garden display. Please contact me for my additional list in May.

To check if varieties are sold out please use our web site which will be up and running before late March.

For Societies who have special classes at their shows, I can provide special rates for bulk orders of any one type of bulb. Please contact me for further details.

Jim Pearce (CP) 2W-P^o Seedling No. 1-16-91
This flower has the deepest red/pink colour that I have seen. The White perianth is almost round in shape. The whole flower is in Perfect proportion. Mid season. 5 only £17.50

The most refined daffodil in this section ever produced. The white perianth is round with a beautiful flat corona. Mid/late season. 10 only £17.50
