ABIQUA..J-5/2 Binkie X Limeade 2 Y-Y 1985 M Ht. 42cm. Medium yellow, perianth broad, flat, semi-pointed. Cup fluted midway to margin, color a bit deeper than perianth. Good stem and pose. Garden or show. Each.....\$8.00

BRANDY..K-27 Green Island X 2 W-Y sdlg. 2 Y-Y 1977 M Ht. 42cm. One of the toned flowers which opens with broad, smooth white perianth, then ages to yellow-beige. Cup fluted and deeper than perianth. Tall, stiff stem and short neck. Each.....\$5.00

CANAPE..J-51 (Duke of Windsor X Lady Kesteven) X 2 W-Y sdlg. Opens white with yellow cup, perianth ages to deep cream. Medium length cup changes from primrose to peachy buff with lighter margin. Tall stem and short neck. Each.....\$5.00

CANEMAH..0-25 (Binkie X 1 Y-W sdlg.) X Suede 2 Y-WY 1978 M Ht. 38cm. Resembles Fettle in form and color. Perianth broad, some reflex, good substance. Cup fades to near white with narrow band of yellow on rim. Each.....\$7.00

CEREMONY..K-27/1 Green Island X 2b sdlg. 2 YYY M Ht. 46cm. Murray felt this is the champion chameleon of the several toned flowers they had introduced. Like the others, it opens white with yellow cup, then at maturity the perianth is deep apricot beige. As it ages, the cup intensifies to a rich apricot-orange. Perianth segments are more pointed than others in the series and could be smoother. A striking, durable garden subject on a tall, stiff stem. Some may be smooth enough for show. Stock very limited. Each.....\$10.00

CHANTICLEER..N-11 (double yellow-orange sdlg.) X Zanzibar 4 Y-YO 1979 M Ht. 38cm. Brilliant and almost sunproof, nicely formed and not too dense. Rich yellow, center deep orange red. Strong stem. Scarce. Each.....\$20.00

CHAPERONE..N-43/1 (Hotspur X I-8) 2 W-O 1979 M Ht. 36cm. Opens dazzling white, with wide, flat, smooth perianth. Cup tapered, lovely shade of orange. Strong stem, bloom will poised. Small stock. Each.....\$10.00

DREAMBOAT..N-36/3 Marchfire X Hotspur 2 W-Wyo 1980 N Ht. 39cm. Unlike others from this cross, it does not open pure white, but soon attains desired purity. Classic show form, cup with deep yellow center, wide orange-red band. Each.....\$8.00

ENSEMBLE..Q-23/1 (double sdlg. X Dawnlight) X (Daydream X New Era) 4 Y-Y 1986 EM Ht. 43cm. Loosely constructed of 4 distinct layers of alternate petals and stamenoids. Inner segments darker. Long lasting on strong stem. Each.....\$10.00

EPITOME.. K-39 Daydream X New Era 1 Y-WWY 1974 EM Ht. 45cm. Tall, smooth, good form and deep yellow for its type. Tapered trumpet-fades to off-white, retaining a narrow band of yellow on the fluted margin. Still scarce. Each.....\$10.00

EVERGOLD..0-12 (Enmore X Fiji) 1 Y-Y 1980 M Ht. 40cm. Murray felt this the best all-purpose deep yellow trumpet they had raised. Has all the qualities for show and garden. Strong, tall stems hold blooms erect in most weather. Each.....\$7.00

FETTLE..L-22 (Binkie X Daydream) X Protege 1 Y-Y 1977 M Ht. 43cm. The roundish, reflexed perianth is primrose-beige. Trumpet flares at margin, with uniform serrations. Tall stem, short neck, bloom upward of 90 degrees. Each.....\$10.00

FOUNT..L-2 (Interim X 2 W-P sdlg.) 1976 M Ht. 39cm. Fairly large, with broad, semi-pointed perianth. Cup with some taper is scalloped at margin, rich salmon pink throughout. Each.....\$5.00

HEADWAY..N-61 Spanixh Gold X Dividend 1 Y-Y 1985 L. Ht. 39cm. Only for those who want a golden yellow thrupet that blooms with the poets. Perianth broad, smooth, a bit wavy. Trumpet tapered with roll at margin. Strong stem. Each.....\$5.00

LIPSTICK..N-66 Multnomah X Firecracker 2 Y-RR 1979 EM Ht. 45cm. Good for garden, some smooth enough for show. Intense, lasting color even in warm climates. Color coded as red, probably deep orange in some climates. Tall and brilliant. Each.....\$8.00

MOHAWK..K-38/2 (2W-Y sdlg. X Accent) 1977 M Ht. 43c. The broad, semi-pointed, fairly smooth perianth opens white, then ages to Jersey cream. Cup turns to light apricot from primrose yellow. Heavy stem and good neck. Each.....\$10.00

MOTTO..N-36/5 Marshfire X Hotspur 3 W-YYO 1982 M Ht. 45cm. Another icy white sister of Dreamboat, Urbane and Verve. Perianth round and smooth, flattish cup yellow with wide band of orange-red. Each.....\$8.00

NABOB..N-55/1 Chemawa X (Paricutin X Rustom Pasha) 2 Y-OOY
1982 EM Ht. 48cm. Perianth deep gold, round and smooth. Cup deep
orange, edged with narrow rim of yellow. Tall, well poised on strong
stem. Almost sunproof. Each.....\$8.00

NUTMEG..K-38/1 2 W-Y sdlg. X Accent 2 W-Y 1976 M Ht. 45cm.
Opens white with yellow cup and round, heavy, white perianth which
goes pale fawn with age. The frilled cup is creamy buff at maturity.
Tall and durable. Each.....\$5.00

PASTIME..0-23/1 Fine Gold X (Kingscourt X Roundabout) 1 Y-Y
1985 EM Ht. 44cm. Perianth broad and round for a yellow trumpet
daffodil. Trumpet tapered and serrated at margin. Bloom poised
above 90 degrees. Each.....\$5.00

PICNIC..K-38 2 W-Y sdlg. X Accent 2 W-Y 1976 M Ht. 45cm. Opens
white with yellow cup, which ages to creamy buff-apricot. Perianth
acquires some of the cup color. Well formed and durable, pretty in all
phases. Each.....\$5.00

PINK WING..P-5 (Rose City X Irish Rose) X (K-44 X Caro Nome) 2
W-P. Tall, well poised on short neck. Perianth broad and smooth.
Cup lightly frilled, pale to deep pink, depending on season. Vigorous
grower. Scarce. Each.....\$10.00

PLUSH..N-15 4 W-WO sdlg. X Hallali 4 W-WR 1978 M Ht. 38cm.
Medium sized double with round, snow white perianth segments.
Loosely doubled center is bright red. Well poised on strong stem.
Very small stock. Each.....\$7.00

PORTRAIT..L-30/2 Cordial X Caro Nome 2 W-P 1983 M Ht. 37 cm.
Sister of Dewy Rose and Ken's Favorite. Smoother than either of its
sibs. Perianth broad and clean white. Cup deep rose pink, some frill,
margin. Each.....\$10.00

PROTEGE..F-297 (Trousseau X Pink O'Dawn) X 2 Y-Y sdlg. 2 Y-Y.
Smooth flower of buff primrose yellow. Ideal form and proportions.
Makes large, firm, short necked bulbs. Each.....\$5.00

REPLETE..1-43/1 Pink Chiffon X Accent 4 W-WP 1975 EM Ht.
43cm. Good form and poise. Center petaloids a pleasing shade of
pink. Eclipsed now by newer pink doubles, still has breeding poten-
tial. Each.....\$5.00

ROYAL COACHMAN..C-115 Rose Marie X Carolina 2 W-GYO 1969
M Ht. 51cm. Colorful, tall, and with good form. Named for the Royal
Coachman trout fly, which is white, green, red and yellow. Fades in
sun, as do most of this type. Each.....\$3.00

SOUBRETTE..H-30 Blarney X (Siam X Green Island) 2 W-Y 1974 M
Ht. 41cm. Perianth clean white and round. The 17mm. cup is butter
yellow and with some flare. Good pose, and nice for garden or show.
Each.....\$3.00

SUN BALL..L-42 Double sdlg. X Dawnlight 4 Y-YY 1976 M Ht.
37cm. The only double we have grown that survives 50 mph winds
unscathed. Canary yellow with deep yellow center. Good form, and
very durable. Scarce. Each.....\$20.00

SURTSEY..E-220 Zarah Leander X Porthilly 2 Y-R 1971 L Ht. 43cm.
Often as fiery as the volcano that bears its name. Late and colorful.
Sun resistant cup, its margin fluted and shirred. Fairly smooth, broad
perianth. Each.....\$2.00

SWEET PRINCE..I-17 Daydream X (Lunar Sea X Galway) 1 Y-WWY
M Ht. 42cm. Uniform gold, trumpet ages to off-white, retaining
narrow band of gold on margin. White halo at base. Show and garden.
Very small stock. Each.....\$15.00

TILLAMOOK..L-29 2 W-Y sdlg. X Accent 2 W-O 1977 M Ht. 39cm.
Opens white with yellow cup. perianth remains white, cup progresses
through deeper shades to rich ripe pumpkin color or famous Tillamook
cheddar cheese. A favorite. Each.....\$10.00

TOURNAMENT..F-313/1 Falaise X (Duke of Windsor X Lady
Kesteven) 4 W-RW 1970 EM Ht. 45cm. Large, early double with
orange-red center. Vigorous, dependable, and some have qualified for
show. Each.....\$3.00

VERVE..N-36/1 Marshfire X Hotspur 2 W-YOO 1978 M Ht. 38cm.
Perianth smooth, flat and very white. Cup yellow in throat, blending
to deep orange outward to rim. Fades in sun; better for show than
garden. Small stock. Each.....\$10.00

YAMHILL..K-7 Oneonta X Protege 2 W-YYW 1978 M Ht. 45cm.
Perianth opens light beige, fades to off-white and is broad and smooth.
Cup primrose, whitish margin. Tall, well poised and elegant.
Each.....\$5.00

YELLOWSTONE..F-264/2 Content X Lunar Sea 1 Y-W 1969 E Ht.
41cm. Voted best sdlg. at the A.D.S. Convention in 1968. Perianth
broad, reflexed, pale yellow. Trumpet with "King Alfred" roll ages to
white. Smooth show and garden. Each.....\$5.00

YOSEMITE..C-138 Radiation X (Trousseau X Pink O'Dawn) 2 W-W
1969 M Ht. 43cm. Perianth like Ave, but not so pointed. Due to
genes of Trousseau it resists basal rot. Good all purpose white flower.
