These are very special plants not available elsewhere in the UK, and won't be in any quantity for several more years. Now is your chance to buy one of these very rare and beautiful anemones. UK and EU orders NOT containing any of Brian Duncan's plants will be sent as soon as I can. UK orders including Brian's plants will be sent as soon as I can get the bulbs from him, probably August. Orders to outside the EU will all be sent together some time in August, as they will all need to be inspected together by FERA before dispatch. Snowdrops, Fritillaria davidii and anemones will be damp-packed for posting. All plants are flowering size, unless otherwise specified.

POSTAGE AND PACKING- -£4-50 per order. I am asking for less than the actual cost of delivery and packaging. If your order can be sent as Large Letter, I will refund any extra postage. Parcels will be sent by first class post, recorded delivery, so will need to be signed for. Orders can be collected from my home address if you are in the area.



<p>Acis nicaeensis</p> <p>£1 15 available</p>	<p>Formerly Leucojum nicaeense, a pretty little April-flowering bulb. Grows to 8-10cm, with 2 or 3 little white lampshades per stem. Survived -7°C under glass last winter. Dry summer rest.</p>	
<p>Adoxa moschatellina</p> <p>£2 10 available</p>	<p>Town Hall Clock. A native plant with anemone-like foliage and small curious green flowers composed of five florets, one each pointing in four directions outwards and one pointing straight up.</p>	
<p>Anemone apennina alba</p> <p>£2 10 available</p>	<p>Delicate spring anemone like a smaller version of Anemone blanda. This is the white form.</p>	
<p>Anemone nemorosa</p> <p>£1-50 10 available</p>	<p>Wild English type. Well-loved woodland anemone flowering March to April. White, often tinged pink. To 15cm.</p>	
<p>Anemone nemorosa 'Bracteata'</p> <p>£2.50 5 available</p>	<p>Wood anemone with double white flowers where some of the petals have become leaves.</p>	
<p>Anemone nemorosa 'Evelyn Meadows'</p> <p>£5 2 available</p>	<p>Beautiful wood anemone with dark red buds and reddish foliage with semi-double white flowers. One per customer.</p>	
<p>Anemone nemorosa 'Flore Pleno'</p> <p>£2 15 available</p>	<p>The naming of this variety is not 100% certain. Similar to 'Vestal', but later flowering and having no stamens so a cleaner, neater looking flower - our favourite.</p>	

<p>Anemone nemorosa 'Maret'</p> <p>£10 3 available</p>	<p>New variety from Taavi Tuulik in Estonia. Lovely large semi-double white flowers. One per customer.</p>	
<p>Anemone nemorosa 'Salt and Pepper'</p> <p>£5 3 available</p>	<p>Curious wood anemone with a central button of short white 'petals, sometimes tinged with brown or olive green, surrounded by the ring of stamens.</p>	
<p>Anemone nemorosa 'Tups'</p> <p>£7 3 available</p>	<p>Another beautiful find by Taavi, with pleasingly full large semi-double flowers, occasionally with streaks of green.</p>	
<p>Anemone nemorosa 'Virescens'</p> <p>£1.50 20 available</p>	<p>All petals replaced by leaves to give a rosette effect. The first variety into 'flower' and the longest lasting since the 'petals' never drop.</p>	
<p>Anemone ranunculoides 'Golden Dream'</p> <p>£30.00 8 available</p>	<p>Fabulous new variety from Taavi Tuulik in Estonia. Yellow flowers with variable ruff of dark green petaloid stamens in centre. One per customer.</p>	
<p>Anemone ranunculoides Hiiumaa</p> <p>£20.00 10 available</p>	<p>Beautiful new variety from Taavi Tuulik in Estonia. Yellow flowers with a boss of narrow yellow petaloid stamens in centre. Max 2 per customer.</p>	
<p>Anemone ranunculoides 'Kassari'</p> <p>£20.00 2 available</p>	<p>Similar to Hiiumaa above, the petaloids being rather shorter in this variety. One per customer.</p>	
<p>Anemone ranunculoides 'Laciniata'</p> <p>£1.50 15 available</p>	<p>A very compact form of A. ranunculoides in which the foliage is quite dark at emergence and flowering time, which sets off the golden flowers beautifully.</p>	


Anemone ranunculoides 'Papa' £25.00 4 available	Another Estonian double, with very neat, full flowers. One per customer.	
Anemone ranunculoides 'Pleniflora' £1.50 10 available	Semi-double golden yellow flowers, vigorous.	
Anemone x lipsiensis 'Stiby' £20 12 available	Previously referred to as bracteate Swedish form, I now have a cultivar name. An unusual form found on Osterlen, in Sweden. A bracteate form of the hybrid between Anemone nemorosa and A. ranunculoides, with some of the petals partly converted to leaves. Max 3 per customer.	
Colchicum baytopiorum £2.50 5 available	Curious corms which lie horizontally, with runners. Several bright pinkish flowers appear in autumn, then short narrow leaves.	Sorry no image
Crocus banaticus £2 each or 6 for £10 30 available	Beautiful autumn-flowering crocus. Three long outer petals, three shorter upright inner ones and long lilac stigmata. Easy and reliable even outside here.	
Crocus banaticus First Snow £8 10 available	Pure white form of the species from Janis Ruksans.	
Crocus biflorus biflorus £2 8 available	Lovely spring crocus with buff coloured outer petals strongly feathered in deep maroon, over white inners.	
Crocus biflorus ssp nubigena £5 4 available	Striking spring crocus, the white flowers tinged buff on the outside, streaked with dark purple and characteristic very dark brownish-black anthers, which split to show the yellow pollen.	
Crocus biflorus Sunspot £6 5 available	Fabulous crocus with deep gold flowers offset by a wonderful black stigma. Often has more than 6 petals, and usually more than one flower per corm.	
Crocus heuffelianus ex National Park £2.50 or 3 for £6 20 available	Mixed seedlings from the Janis Ruksans selection of Crocus heuffelianus. These are variously marked and tipped with white and deep purple. These are unselected seedlings, so it's pot luck, but I like them all	

Crocus gargaricus £2 3 available	Spring crocus with deepest gold flowers.	
Crocus reticulata x angustifolia 'Janis Ruksans' £2.50 6 available	An early-flowering crocus with deep yellow, pointed segments, very dark purplish-brown on the back, with a narrow yellow edge. Free flowering.	Sorry no image
Crocus sieberi Ronald Ginns £2.50 4 available	Beautifully marked crocus from Ray Cobb, and a good doer. Pale violet flowers with yellow throat, and purple speckling on outside of petals.	
Crocus veluchensis x cvjicii Rainbow 'Gold' £9 5 available	Choice rare hybrid crocus with pale yellow blooms, overlain with purple to give a curious 'shot' effect.	
Crocus tommasinianus Bobbo £9 5 available	An eye-catching form of this easy spring crocus with lavender flowers neatly tipped with white.	
Crocus tommasinianus Eric Smith £3 10 available	Pretty crocus with white flowers which usually have extra petals. Photo Mark Smyth.	
Crocus tommasinianus Roseus £3 10 available	Pretty 'Tommy' with deep pink flowers opening from greyish buds.	
Crocus tommasinianus white/blue stripe £3 6 available	This form has white flowers with delicate lilac lines on the segments, from Janis Ruksans. An eye-catching form of this easy spring crocus with lavender flowers neatly tipped with white.	
Cyclamen hederifolium Fairy Rings £3 6 available	Selected for the foliage patterns. These are 2 year old seedlings and may flower this autumn. The photograph is of the plants offered.	
Eranthis x tubergenii 'Guinea Gold' £5-00 10 available	Choice hybrid between E. hyemalis and E. cilicica, later flowering and with larger flowers and bronzy leaves.	
Fritillaria aurea £5-00 4 available	A charmer, only a few cm high with large chubby bells of golden yellow chequered with black.	


<p>Fritillaria davidii</p> <p>£5 5 available</p>	<p>A very unusual Chinese fritillaria with yellow chubby bells chequered with brown on short stalks. The leaves are fascinating, ground hugging, leathery and with netted veins. Small bulbs offered, and I will put in some rice-grain bulblets for you to grow on as well.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Angelique'</p> <p>£10 6 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 13cm. Charming semi-poculiform.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Anne of Geierstein'</p> <p>£10 3 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 120mm. The flowers are very thick-petalled and solid looking.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Armine'</p> <p>£10 9 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 160mm. Large flowers on short stems, curved spathe.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Bertram Anderson'</p> <p>£7 40 available</p>	<p>An early flowering snowdrop with large, thick textured flowers on upright stems.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Bill Bishop'</p> <p>£7 25 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 12cm. Huge flowers on short arching stems. Outer petals longer than the similar Bertram Anderson.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Blewbury Tart'</p> <p>£5 20 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 18cm. Flowers face outwards displaying dark green undersides of inner segments. Leaves at flowering time 7x170mm, bluish, upright.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Blonde Inge'</p> <p>£10 6 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 100mm. Green ovary, yellow mark on inners.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Cedric's Prolific'</p> <p>£4 20 available</p>	<p>Tall, vigorous snowdrop selected by Beth Chatto. Flowers have a two-tone X on inner segments.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Cicely Hall'</p> <p>£18 1 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 11cm. Distinctive dark green spherical ovary and short pedicel.</p>	



<p>Galanthus 'Comet'</p> <p>£6 5 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 150mm. Scapes arching, Flower large with long pedicel.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Compton Court'</p> <p>£4, or 5 for £15 55 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 19cm. Scapes upright, fat rounded buds, shapely flowers. Vigorous, good garden variety which increases well.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Cordelia'</p> <p>£6 12 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 20cm. Neat Greatorex double.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Curly'</p> <p>£7 6 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 18cm. Two-tone X on inners. Very fragrant.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Elfin'</p> <p>£8 5 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 13cm. Nice little green-tipped miniature like a smaller Scharlockii.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Emerald Isle'</p> <p>£15 2 available</p>	<p>A rare virescent variety of G. ikariae. Flowering height 9cm.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Falkland House'</p> <p>£7 5 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 13cm. Scapes upright, Flower length including ovary 28mm. Leaves at flowering time 11x130mm, glaucous, upright.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Faringdon Double'</p> <p>£6 or 3 for £15 40 available</p>	<p>This is the earliest of the double snowdrops, flowering here in mid-December last year. It has a sturdy upright habit, and well shaped, large flowers.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'G71'</p> <p>£8-00 2 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 14cm. Scapes upright, buds fat round. Flower length including ovary 25mm. Leaves at flowering time 8x80mm, glaucous, spreading. Greatorex double.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Ginns' Imperati'</p> <p>£4 20 available</p>	<p>A vigorous mid-season snowdrop famed for its powerful almond scent.</p>



<p>Galanthus 'Greenish'</p> <p>£8 8 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 8cm. A dainty small plant making very small bulbs. Double nosed bulbs offered.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Hill Poë'</p> <p>£7 15 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 16cm. Neat and tidy double, my favourite.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'James Backhouse'</p> <p>£3 15 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 26cm. Flowers unstable, often having extra outer segments or other weirdnesses. Early.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Jacquenetta'</p> <p>£5 20 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 18cm. Scapes upright. Flower usually with green lines on outers Greatorex double.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'John Gray'</p> <p>£7 15 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 17cm. Large flowers, distinctive markings.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Lapwing'</p> <p>£8 10 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 20cm. Two-tone green X on inners.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Lavinia'</p> <p>£4 7 available</p>	<p>Greatorex double. Flowering height 13cm. Inverted heart on inners.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Lerinda'</p> <p>£3-00 20 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 18cm. Shapely snowdrop with rounded flowers. Vigorous.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Mark's Tall'</p> <p>£5 10 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 20cm. Good inverted heart on inners. When I first saw this variety in Ireland it was 50cm high! Found by Mark Smyth.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Melanie Broughton'</p> <p>£6 6 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 18 cm. Leaves at flowering time 20x90mm, bluish, arching. Inners mostly green, spherical ovary.</p>	




<p>Galanthus 'Merlin'</p> <p>£5 30 available</p>	<p>Classic snowdrop with its signature small spherical ovary and almost all green inner segments.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Mighty Atom'</p> <p>£8 25 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 8cm. Scapes upright. Flower length including ovary 40mm. Leaves at flowering time 7x60mm, glaucous, prostrate. Small plant – big flower.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Mrs McNamara'</p> <p>£7 or 3 for £18 40 available</p>	<p>A classy snowdrop usually flowering in January, well shaped solid flowers held above the spathe, and the flowers presented well above glaucous leaves.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Mrs Thompson'</p> <p>£12-00 15 available</p>	<p>A beautiful snowdrop, despite being completely crazy and frequently producing an assortment of flower types, from two to a scape, or several extra segments, sometimes two flowers fused together.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Nerissa'</p> <p>£4 20 available</p>	<p>Greatorex double. Scapes upright. Leaves glaucous yellowish, arching.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Ophelia'</p> <p>£6 10 available</p>	<p>Greatorex double. Flowering height 18cm. Leaves glaucous, arching.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Peg Sharples'</p> <p>£10 5 available</p>	<p>A distinctive and beautiful flower, not often offered, and particularly late flowering so will extend your snowdrop season.</p>	
<p>Galanthus peshmenii</p> <p>£4-00 or 3 for £11-00 20 available</p>	<p>Dainty autumn flowering snowdrop with flowers 12cm high before the leaves in Sep-Oct. Leaves are glaucous. I grow mine in an alpine house where it is easy given a dry summer rest.</p>	
<p>Galanthus peshmenii Kastellorizo</p> <p>£8 8 available</p>	<p>As it grows with me, similar to straight peshmenii, but a little larger and more robust-looking.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Primrose Warburg'</p> <p>£15 20 available</p>	<p>Glaucous leaved snowdrop with well-shaped flowers with an oval yellow ovary, and greenish yellow apical mark with rounded ends on inner segments.</p>	



Galanthus 'Pusey Greentips' £5 10 available	Flowering height 16cm. Scapes short, upright, large double, green-tipped flower hanging vertically downward like a street lamp.	
Galanthus reginae-olgae £5 10 available	Welcome autumn-flowering snowdrop, and one to surprise the neighbours with if you plant it near your front door! Hardy planted outside here, does well at the base of trees where it is quite dry in the summer.	
Galanthus 'Rodmarton' £10 3 available	Flowering height 12cm. Double with nice green lines on outer segments.	
Galanthus 'Ronald Mackenzie' £40 1 available	Rare yellow elwesii. Flowering height 20cm. Unique yellow marks at base and apex of inner segments.	
Galanthus 'Sandersii' £8 15 available	syn 'Lutescens' Flowering height 14cm. Yellow mark and ovary.	
Galanthus 'Scharlockii' £4 or 3 for £10 20 available	Flowering height 110mm. Long pedicel and long split spathe making 'Donkey ears' Delicate looking and distinctive plant, vigorous and good increaser.	
Galanthus 'Selborne Greentips' £10 10 available	Flowering height 16cm. Sometimes has 2 flowers on the same stem, mature flowers have reflexed outers. Delighted this spring to see that all the bulbs had twin flowers and green tips, but these features can be absent some years.	
Galanthus 'Spindlestone Surprise' £12 40 available	Green-leaved snowdrop with yellow ovary and greenish yellow apical mark on inner segments with pointed ends. Vigorous.	
Galanthus 'The Pearl' £9 6 available	Flowering height 23cm. Elegant drop-shaped buds.	
Galanthus 'Three Ships' £15 10 available	Flowering height 150mm. Famously flowers in December, very long lasting flowers. The good X-mark on inners and crinkled outers would make it a desirable snowdrop even if it flowered with everything else. Deservedly popular.	


Galanthus transcaucasicus £15 1 available	Flowering height 6cm. Leaves, glossy green, arching. Delightful and distinctive, rarely offered.	
Galanthus 'Trym' £12 2 available	Flowering height 200mm. The original reverse poculiform, with marks at the ends of the outer segments, which are slightly relaxed.	
Galanthus 'Trymlet' £20 6 available	Flowering height 15cm. Inverse poculiform with neat green mark at apex of outer segments. Chipped bulbs can lose this mark permanently, probably accounting for its scarcity in the trade. These have been checked.	
Galanthus Galanthus 'Tubby Merlin' £8 10 available	Flowering height 17cm. Scapes upright, ovary yellowish. Flower has all-green inners. Leaves at flowering glaucous, prostrate, displaying the flowers well. Early.	
Galanthus 'Vic Horton' £4 10 available	A variety of <i>G. gracilis</i> . Flowering height 13cm. Leaves at flowering time arching, twisted. Inners with basal mark and usually 2 green dots at the apex.	
Galanthus 'Washfield Colesbourne' £10 5 available	Flowering height 20cm. Classy snowdrop with all-green inners.	
Galanthus 'Wasp' £12 4 available	Flowering height 12cm. Very long narrow flower.	
Galanthus 'Wendy's Gold' £10 or 3 for £25 45 available	A vigorous <i>plicatus</i> variety with all yellow markings.

Narcissus albidus SF110 £1.50 20 available	December flowering hoop petticoat with good solid white flowers. An excellent parent producing beautiful seedlings.	
Narcissus albidus ex SF110 £1 20 available	December flowering hoop petticoat with good solid white flowers. These are seedlings from this form.	

<p>Narcissus albidus SF110 x bulbocodium praecox Moulay Brahim £1 10 available</p>	<p>A very nice group of mixed seedlings with creamy flowers of good substance and texture. About 15cm high, flowering in February.</p>	
<p>Narcissus alpestris £7.50 10 available</p>	<p>BD Beautiful and graceful species with hanging flowers of milky white. Grows to about 20cm.</p>	
<p>Narcissus 'Angel's Flight' £20 3 available</p>	<p>BD 6W-W(N. cyclamineus select x Candlepower) This is a slightly taller version of 'Cheep' with distinctly toothed flange at the mouth of the trumpet.</p>	
<p>Narcissus asturiensis £2.50 10 available</p>	<p>This is a relatively tall form, mixed seedlings growing to 10-18cm tall.</p>	
<p>Narcissus asturiensis x cyclamineus £7.00 4 available</p>	<p>A smaller version of Sidora (below) growing to only 10cm, and flowering in March. Admired at the shows, but always scarce. One per customer.</p>	
<p>Narcissus 'Atlas Gold' £3.00 20 available</p>	<p>Hoop petticoat daffodil with widely-flaring golden yellow flowers. A selection of N. romieuxii JCA805Y.</p>	
<p>Narcissus 'Atlas Gold' x albidus SF110 £2.00 20 available</p>	<p>A mixed group of beautiful seedlings from these two excellent parents. They are heavily textured with bright white flowers, mostly widely flared and some with rolled-back rims.</p>	
<p>Narcissus 'Baby Moon' seedlings £3.00 for 6 30 available</p>	<p>BD Open -pollinated seedlings. Several sweetly scented golden yellow flowers to each stem.</p>	
<p>Narcissus BD 3466 £15 2 available</p>	<p>BD 8W-WWP (Soprano x N. dubius). Opens with an attractive pink rim to the shallow cup. 2-3 flrs. Per stem. Needs summer heat for best flowering. Very scarce.</p>	Sorry no photo



<p>Narcissus bulbocodium 'Big Bob' £4 10 available</p>	<p>BD Nice golden hoop petticoat, likely with some obesus blood, with large bells and vivid green stripes on the tube and perianth.</p>	
<p>Narcissus bulbocodium general blend £10 for 12 100 available</p>	<p>BD Species and hybrid seedlings- ranging from 2" to 18" high in the full range of colours from Golden Yellow, Lemon, Limey, Cream and White</p>	Sorry no photo
<p>Narcissus bulbocodium var. nivalis £3.50 2 available</p>	<p>Tiny hoop petticoat from seeds collected near Bragança in Portugal. Flowers are barely more than 1cm in diameter on short stems to 8cm high. Great for troughs. Early</p>	
<p>Narcissus bulbocodium subsp praecox var paucinervis RRW84.18 £2.50 20 available</p>	<p>Pale yellow hoop with upward facing flowers, a Bob and Rannveig Wallis collection. Anout 10cm in flower.</p>	
<p>Narcissus bulbocodium tenuifolius £2 15 available</p>	<p>Another small yellow hoop petticoat good for a trough, very late flowering to extend the season.</p>	Sorry no photo
<p>Narcissus bulbocodium x hedraeanthus BD 03/53 £12 for 5 25 available</p>	<p>BD Moroccan <i>bulbocodiums</i> x <i>N. hedraeanthus</i> to give short stems. Stems are about 6" tall and the flowers are upfacing stargazers. Opens mid January. Blend of lemon yellow and white well formed flowers. Lovely tidy pot plants. Long lasting.</p>	
<p>Narcissus calcicola 'Idol' x watieri £3.00 25 available</p>	<p>Neat little hybrids, mostly about 15cm tall with 2 to 3 lemon flowers per stem.</p>	
<p>Narcissus cantabricus cantabricus £4.00 for 5 55 available</p>	<p>Very vigorous seedlings to about 14cm high with sparkling white flowers. Multiplies quickly.</p>






