ALINTA* (C) 3W-YYR (76-5) 3-4 Bred Placid x Ariston (Name changed from "Arika" for RHS Registration) RHS Colour Chart perianth 155D; outer cup 28B. Very clean white rounded petals of excellent substance. Frilled cup has inner half of yellow merging into outer band of deep red. Strong stem and neck. Well posed. Consistent. The cup tends to burn, so pick soon after opening for a real show winner. Champion Small Cup, Launceston, 1981.

BELGARD (C) 1Y-Y (29-6) 1 Bred Chillion x Warbin. A smooth self yellow of deep maximus gold; well posed on tall stems; trumpet has lightly expanded frilly edge.

ELMARA* (C) 4Y-Y (61-6) Bred Camelot x (Kingscourt & Fiji Sdlg) I think this is the best of the hundreds and hundreds of all yellow daffodils I have raised. A full flower of uniform golden yellow of tremendous substance. Well posed on a strong stem it does not normally have stigma or pollen but has had both after hot water treatment.

INDORA* (C) 4W-WP (73-4) 2-3 Bred Rhana x Kimellen. A lovely flower whose wide petals are interspersed with fairly large ruffed petals which are a distinct soft pink. A full heavy head has a strong neck and is well posed on a strong round stem.

TASLASS* (C) 4W-WY (78-4) 3 Bred Gideon x White Lion RHS Colour Chart perianth 155A petaloids 8D. A round double with smooth round perianth segments and in the centre smaller petals interspersed with yellow. A lovely full flower of tremendous substance.

1985 Releases

AKORA* (C) 4Y-Y (24-28) Mid-Season Bred V1X1 Kingscourt-Fiji). A most attractive all yellow double of tremendous substance well posed on a strong stem. RHS Colour Chart perianth 9A; petaloids 14A. Champion double Hobart 1983.

ALKIRA (C) 2Y-Y (79-6) (name changed from 'Aralia') Latish mid season. Bred Olympic Gold x Camelot. Rounded full petals with a narrow cup that is lightly frilled, a very attractive flower.

BALANDRA* (C) 4Y-Y (128-5) Late. Breeding uncertain. A distinguished, all yellow double with very good stem, neck and pose RHS Colour Chart shows perianth 9A and petaloids 14A.

ELWOOD DRIVE (C) 1Y-Y (28-5) Early. Bred Chillion x Warbin. Smooth flat perianth segments of good substance and a pleasant frilly cup lightly expanded at the mouth; a useful addition to the range of early trumpets.

KAMURA (C) 2W-P (90-5) Mid season. Bred Lawali x Nina. Clean white petals of good substance and a slightly expanded shortish cup of mid-pink.

NIGHTCAP (C) 1Y-Y (131-5) Late. Bred Mireen x Olympic Gold. A well posed flower that is much the the latest of all the yellow trumpets I grow. Valuable for late shows and breeding late varieties.

ONIBI (C) 3Y-O (28-4) Late. Breeding uncertain. Good bright smooth yellow petals with a splayed cup of solid reddish-orange. Cup has a frilled edge. Good stem and pose.
