



# HOW TO USE THIS CATALOGUE

**FLOWER TYPE:** Daffodils are classified into 12 Divisions (Refer back cover). The figure immediately after the variety name is the DAFFODIL DIVISION NUMBER.

**FLOWER COLOR:** Is described by letters following the Division Number. The first letter indicates petal (perianth) color. Additional letter(s) indicate color of trumpet or cup from the centre through to the edge. Colors applicable to the descriptions are abbreviated as follows:

<b>Y: Yellow</b>	<b>P: Pink</b>
<b>W: White or Whitish</b>	<b>O: Orange</b>
<b>G: Green</b>	<b>R: Red</b>

**TIME OF FLOWERING** is shown after each description (varies according to locality).

Superb golden-yellow exhibition bloom with flat perianth of excellent substance; long, fluted trumpet rolls back at the edge. Mid to Late. . . . . \$4.95

### DOUBLE FLOWERS

#### **Double Event: 4W-Y**

A beautiful, very full round flower; large, pure white segments are interspersed with small segments of soft lemon-yellow. Bred in Ireland. Tall, robust. Late. . . . . \$5.95

#### **Fiji: 4Y-Y**

(See photo - back cover)

Superb, very full round show bloom with large deep yellow petals interspersed in the centre with smaller deep gold segments. Mid to Late. . . . . \$12.95

#### **Gay Record: 4W-WOO**

A fine, well-balanced double bloom; the full head has broad, white outer perianth segments and beautifully placed white inner segments contrasting with the smaller, bright tangerine orange petaloides interspersed amongst them. Late. . . . . \$14.95

#### **Gay Time: 4W-WRR**

Full, large show flower with creamy-white broad, outer petals. The narrower, pointed inner petals are interspersed with bright orange-red segments. Late. . . . . \$6.95

#### **Irish Gift: 4W-WRR**

Magnificent, perfumed exhibition double of excellent substance; opens cream and soon passes to white; smaller, crinkled, intense orange-red petals are interspersed thought the centre. Tall, vigorous. Late to Very Late. . . . \$17.95

#### **Lawali: 4Y-P**

Splendid semi-double bloom; pure white perianth often has additional petals; pink frilled cup has a frilled inner cup, plus pink and white petaloids. Sometimes flowers single. Mid to Late. . . . . \$2.95

#### **Monterrico: 4W-WOO**

A huge majestic Irish double; perfectly balanced, excellent quality and substance; pure white, broad overlapping outer petals; smaller inner petals are interspersed with tangerine and orange segments. Strong, vigorous. Late. . . \$17.95

#### **Mrs William Copeland: 4W-W**



# CLASSIFICATION OF DAFFODILS

## DIVISION 1: TRUMPET DAFFODILS OF GARDEN ORIGIN

One flower to the stem, trumpet as long as or longer than the longest petal.

## DIVISION 2: LARGE CUP DAFFODILS OF GARDEN ORIGIN

One flower to a stem, cup more than one-third but not equal to the length of the longest petal.

## DIVISION 3: SMALL CUP DAFFODILS OF GARDEN ORIGIN

One flower to the stem, cup not more than one-third the length of the longest petal.

## DIVISION 4: DOUBLE DAFFODILS OF GARDEN ORIGIN

Double flowers.

## DIVISION 5: TRIANDRUS HYBRIDS OF GARDEN ORIGIN

Usually one or more pendant blooms to a stem.

## DIVISION 6: CYCLAMINEUS HYBRIDS OF GARDEN ORIGIN

Usually reflexed petals and straight sided trumpet or cup predominantly one flower to the stem.

## DIVISION 7: JONQUILLA HYBRIDS OF GARDEN ORIGIN

One or more flowers to a stem, normally fragrant, rush-like leaves.

## DIVISION 8: TAZETTA HYBRIDS OF GARDEN ORIGIN

Several short-cupped, fragrant small flowers bunched on a stem, broad leaves.

Poetaz Hybrids of Garden Origin (Tazetta X Poeticus).

Normally two to four larger flowers to a stem, broad leaves.

## DIVISION 9: POETICUS HYBRIDS OF GARDEN ORIGIN

Normally one fragrant flower per stem, white petals, tiny cup, shades of green, yellow, orange and edged red.

## DIVISION 10: SPECIES AND WILD FORMS

All species and wild hybrids, double species and double wild hybrids included.

## DIVISION 11: SPLIT TRUMPET & SPLIT CUP DAFFODILS OF GARDEN ORIGIN

Trumpet of cup split for a least one-third its length.

## DIVISION 12: MISCELLANEOUS DAFFODILS

Daffodils not falling into any of the foregoing divisions.
