

†N. bulbocodium conspicuus - Unique shaped warm yellow flower. Often called the "Hoop-petticoat" daffodil. Almost total lack of petals produces this unusual appearance. ....	3.75	7.25	14.00

*N. obvallaris (The Tenby Daffodil) - Bright golden yellow medium size trumpet variety on stiff stem. Excellent in grass also indoors in pots. Height about 12 inches. Very fragrant. ....	3.25	6.25	12.00

Division XI

SPLIT-CORONA NARCISSI

Each section of the split-corona of this newer type flower lies flat on the corresponding section of the perianth. When the corona measures at least 2/3 the length of the perianth the flower is referred to as a "Collar" daffodil; when shorter, it is called a "Split-corona".

- BACCARAT** - The dark yellow collar of this well-formed flower provides a nice contrast to the light yellow perianth. The stem is tall and strong; the bloom medium late. .... \$ .75 each
- ORANGERY** - The overlapping petals of the striking white perianth form a fine foil for the yellow-edged warm orange collar. The stem is of medium height; the bloom medium early. .... \$ .75 each
- VALDROME** - This flower has a very flat amber yellow collar which contrasts pleasingly with the white perianth. A very floriferous cultivar on a medium tall stem. Bloom is medium early. .... \$ .85 each
