



Dear Friends,

Jerry and I hope your gardens are doing well. Our severe weather conditions in many parts of the United States caused many plant losses. Here in Northern California, we had 26 inches of rain between Christmas and New Years. We had no personal damage but our garden is very soggy. In late fall, the quail ate our green manure crop leaving bare ground and creating a muddy mess through the winter. However, all of this rain has been a daffodil's paradise.

*James S. Wells collection is increasing well. I feel fortunate to be able to work with these wonderful bulbs and expand their numbers. Over the years I have received a great number of clones of *N. romieuxii* and *N. cantabricus* from Jim. They are slowly increasing and need to be shared. Their numbers are still too few to offer them individually. To help get them increased I am offering them in small, varied collections. Each collection will contain six named and/or numbered bulbs. Try them outdoors if you can grow *N. bulbocodium*, or in a cold greenhouse. They have survived 26 degrees F. in pots here. I ask that anyone purchasing a collection keep them well labelled for future reference. I would appreciate any information back on your experiences with them.*

*All of my bulbs are grown for at least one season to establish health and identity. The species *Narcissus* that I sell are grown from seed or vegetatively divided. They are only sold when the stock is large enough to maintain the population. These beautiful bulbs are rapidly disappearing in the wild due to grazing, road building, mass collecting for commercial purposes and general human population increase. My aim is to preserve these gene pools for future generations. If you are particularly successful with the species you purchase and grow, let me know your circumstances., geographic area, location in your garden, soil and weather conditions. This shared information will help with their survival.*
