SWODS Meeting Sunday, July 29, 2PM

Apologies for the late notice. As previously announced, our summer meeting will be at Ted and Susan Ruoff's home in Morrow. Bring a covered dish and your bathing suit if you want to swim.

The program will consist of a discussion of daffodil bulbs: how to dig them, store them, and care for them; how to tell if one is diseased; and anything else anybody wants to know about bulbs. Bring any odd bulbs as examples if you wish. If anybody has a bulb with a bulb fly larva inside, bring it for others to see (and a needle too for demonstrating extraction of the larva).

We'll have many other items to discuss as well, as indicated in the paragraphs that follow.

We'll talk about the American Daffodil Society convention we are hosting here next spring. We'll describe what is already planned and take suggestions for additional features for the convention.

We'll discuss how we'll manage our bulb sales in the fall.

From the North:

In Lebanon, take Rt. 123 East to the stop light in Morrow (about 7 miles East of I-71)

Turn RIGHT on to Pike Street (Rt. 22&3)

Turn LEFT at next stoplight on to Morrow-Woodville.

Turn RIGHT at the next road on to Morrow-Rosburg (this is more like a Y).

Go to the Morrow Meadow Farms entrance which is the first available left turn.

Turn LEFT on Morrow Meadow Drive and go to the second street which is Orchard View Lane

From the South:

You will be going North of Route 48 on Montgomery Road, so you can pick your options for getting to Montgomery Road.

Go North on Montgomery Road to Morrow-Cozzadale Road (new high school at the corner)

Turn RIGHT on Morrow-Cozzadale Rd.

Turn LEFT on Ludlum Road (first available left turn).

Turn LEFT on Morrow-Rosburg (first stop sign).

Go to Morrow Meadow Farms Entrance (the first right)

Turn RIGHT on Morrow Meadow Drive.

Go to second street which is Orchard View Lane.
