


TERMS

All bulbs are offered subject to being unsold on receipt of order and a satisfactory crop.

Orders should be sent in as early as possible, and should in no case be received later than Mid—August.

All bulbs are sold loco warehouses Holland, and travel at purchaser's risk and expense.

All accounts are strictly due three months after date of invoice; 5 % for cash is allowed for payments within 30 days after date of invoice. On overdue accounts 6 % per annum will be charged, together with the collection expenses.

Orders cannot be cancelled, except by mutual agreement.

Orders under \$10.— must be accompanied by remittance sufficient also to cover the postage.

All bulbs will be sent by Parcel Post, unless contrary orders are given. We suggest small lots being sent by Letter Post, as this is considerably quicker.

Cash or satisfactory reference must accompany all orders from unknown correspondents.

2a **ADVENTURE.** A.M. This large, perfectly formed flower is clear soft yellow throughout, has a broadly overlapping, very flat perianth and a large expanded crown of almost trumpet dimension. Tall and vigorous.

1a **AEROLITE.** Very flat and overlapping soft pale yellow perianth; the rather long trumpet is light golden-yellow.

3b **AFLAME.** F.C.C. Well overlapping and thick sulphur-white perianth; the medium sized crown is intense orange-scarlet. Tall, strong stem.

2a **ANKARA.** A.M. 1943. Large and overlapping soft pale yellow perianth; the rather large and spreading orange-yellow crown is broadly margined bright red. \$ 18.— each

The very thick, much overlapping and broad flat perianth is deepest golden-yellow and the expanded crown is vivid orange-red throughout. 10 **GOLDEN DUCAT.** A.M. 1946. Beautiful pale self-yellow throughout. Several layers of beautiful wax-like petals overlap one another and gradually form a very symmetrical double center. 1a **GOLDEN GODDESS.** A.M. 1946. We consider this one of the finest and most perfectly shaped golden-yellow trumpets in existence to-day. The broad, flat and much overlapping very strong perianth stands at right angles to the beautiful trumpet. A flower without a single fault. Only a few bulbs available yet. \$ 110.— each

1a **GOLDEN HARVEST.** F.C.C. Enormous trumpet of perfect shape and proportions. Deep golden-yellow throughout. \$ 1.— per dozen. \$ 8.— per 100

1a **GOLDEN MARVEL.** A.M. Large, thick and much overlapping perianth, standing at right angles to the large, bold trumpet. This flower of faultless form is clear self golden-yellow throughout. Early and very vigorous. Highly recommended. \$ 24.— each

3b **HADES.** A.M. Soft creamy-white perianth; the expanded crown is deep cherry-red throughout. Recommended. \$ 1.25 per dozen. \$ 10.— per 100

8 **HALVOSE.** A.M. Well overlapping yellow perianth, the petals of which are clearly stained iridescent scarlet; the eye is dark orange-red. \$ 4.— per 100

2b **HARDY.** A.M. 1942. Much overlapping and strong creamy-white perianth. The orange-red crown is semi-double and heavily frilled. A very unique and most attractive flower. \$ 10.— each

2a **HAVELOCK.** F.C.C. Flat and broadly overlapping perianth; the large expanded crown is beautifully flanged at the mouth. Soft golden-yellow throughout. \$ 5.— per 100

2a **HELIOS.** F.C.C. Much overlapping and flat yellow perianth; large orange-yellow trumpet-shaped crown. Very early. \$ 5.— per 100

10 **HOLLANDIA.** A.M. 1943. Classed as a double, but only partly so. The flat and overlapping perianth is yellow and the large, very double crown is deep orange-red. A most attractive and very unusual type flower. \$ 35.— each

2a **HOLLYWOOD.** This very fine flower might best be described as an improved Fortune. Large, much overlapping and flat deep golden-yellow perianth. The large trumpet-shaped crown is clear orange. Strong and very early. New. \$ 24.— each

1b **IMPERATOR.** A.M. Very large and beautiful creamy-white trumpet. Late. \$ 7.50 per 100

10 **INGLESCOMBE.** A.M. A very pleasing soft clear yellow double. \$ 6.— per 100

2b **INGRID.** A.M. 1943. Flat and overlapping, slightly pointed, white perianth; the much expanded and very flat golden-yellow crown is edged bright red. Tall. \$ 2.— each

1a **INSURPASSABLE.** F.C.C. One of the largest trumpets. Broad and much overlapping perianth and a very large and spreading trumpet, beautifully rolled back at the brim. Deepest golden-yellow throughout and much recommended. Early. \$ 1.25 per dozen. \$ 10.— per 100

2b **JOHN EVELYN.** F.C.C. Large white perianth and much expanded, heavily frilled, pale apricot crown. \$ 5.— per 100

Strong, flat and well overlapping perianth, standing at right angles to the bold trumpet. The colour is very pleasing soft golden-yellow throughout. Early and strong. \$ 24.— each

Large flower with broadly overlapping white perianth and perfectly proportioned bowl-shaped crown of intensely vivid dark solid orange-red with a touch of dark green in the center. 4a **LADY BIRD.** A.M. 1946. Soft creamy-white perianth and a salmon-pink, trumpet-shaped crown. \$ 80.— each

3b **LADY DIANA MANNERS.** A.M. Pure white perianth and flat orange crown, margined red. \$ 5.— per 100

3b **LADY KESTEVEN.** F.C.C. Purest snow-white perianth; the cup is intense deep cherry-red throughout. A most attractive flower and well recommended. \$ —.60 each. \$ 55.— per 100

4a **LUDLOW.** F.C.C. Flat and broadly overlapping perianth and a large trumpet-shaped crown. The colour is purest icy-white throughout. Highly recommended. \$ 6.— each

2b **MAGIC CIRCLE.** A.M. 1946. Well overlapping and flat pure white perianth. The large and very flat golden-yellow crown is broadly margined bright scarlet. See illustration front cover. \$ 6.— each

1a **MAGNIFICENCE.** F.C.C. One of the earliest golden-yellow trumpets. \$ 6.— per 100

3a. **MANGOSTEEN.** A.M. Broad and much overlapping brightest yellow perianth; the widely expanded and frilled crown is solid blazing deep orange-scarlet. Recommended. \$ 1.— each

2b **MARCATO.** A.M. Large and much overlapping white perianth; the large and spreading orange-yellow crown is edged bright red. Recommended. \$ 4.— each

2a **MARKSMAN.** A.M. Clear yellow perianth and rather long, orange-red crown. \$ —.80 each

8 **MARTHA WASHINGTON.** A.M. This remarkable variety is classed as a Poetaz, but is better described as Giant Poetaz, as the individual flowers are of Barrii size. Large and strong white perianth and large orange cup. 2, but mostly 3 flowers are carried on a tall, strong stem. Most unusual variety and highly recommended. \$ 2.25 per dozen. \$ 18.— per 100

10 **MARY COPELAND.** F.C.C. The outer petals of this very fine flower are white and the center is bright orange-red \$ 3.— per dozen. \$ 24.— per 100

2a **MARY FLORENCE.** Large bright yellow perianth and a deep orange crown. Strong and vigorous. \$ 1.— per dozen. \$ 8.— per 100

4a **MENTON.** A.M. 1943. Soft creamy-white perianth and large, salmon-pink trumpet shaped crown. Large flower of excellent form. \$ 14.— each

2b **MONIQUE.** F.C.C. The very large pure white perianth is perfectly flat and much overlapping; the widely expanded crown is light orange and darkens towards the edge. Highly recommended. \$ 1.40 per dozen. \$ 11.— per 100

- 1b **MOUNT HOOD.** A.M. Broad and flat, much overlapping strong white perianth, standing at right angles to the large and well proportioned white trumpet. Strong plant and highly recommended. \$ 3.50 per dozen. \$ 27.50 p. 100
- 3b **MRS. BARCLAY.** Flat and round creamy-white perianth. The large and very flat yellow crown is banded bright scarlet. \$ 5.— per 100
- 1b **MRS. E. H. KRELAGE.** F.C.C. Pure white perianth and soft creamy-white trumpet. \$ 6.— per 100
- 4a **MRS. R. O. BACKHOUSE.** A.M. Rather slender creamy-white perianth and a long and narrow, trumpet-shaped crown of pearly-rose. \$ 3.75 per dozen. \$ 30.— per 100
- 10 **MRS. WM. COPELAND.** A.M. This large, well shaped and good double flower is creamy-white throughout. Recommended. \$ —.60 each. \$ 55.— per 100
- 1c **MUSIC HALL.** A.M. Large and well overlapping pure white perianth and a large deep golden-yellow trumpet, widely flanged and rolled back at the mouth. Strong and vigorous. \$ 1.25 per dozen. \$ 10.— per 100
- 2b **NEW DEAL.** Well overlapping white perianth. Very large and spreading, almost flat, orange-red crown, deepening in colour towards the edge. New \$ 10.— each
- 2a **ORANGE BELL.** Very large soft yellow perianth and an enormous crown of deep orange throughout. Early. New \$ 70.— each
- 2b **ORANGE BRIDE.** F.C.C. 1946. Round and flat, much overlapping, large white perianth. The large and spreading, almost flat, strongly frilled and double crown is orange with paler edge and has a greenish center. Only a few bulbs available yet. \$ 16.— each
- 2b **ORANGE COURIER.** A.M. 1946. Large, strong and overlapping pure white perianth. The large and heavily fringed, short trumpet-shaped crown is clear bright orange. Late. \$ 20.— each

- 2b **ORANGE FLAG.** A.M. Much overlapping, strong and flat pale sulphur-white perianth. The large and spreading bowl-shaped crown is deepest orange. Very strong and vigorous. Well recommended. \$ 1.75 per dozen. \$ 14.— per 100
- 2a **ORANGE TRIUMPHATOR.** A.M. Large, round and well overlapping yellow perianth. The enormous, almost flat crown is rich orange-scarlet. \$ 3.— each
- 1c **PATRIA.** A.M. Large silvery-white perianth of perfect shape; the narrow, well balanced and broadly flanged trumpet is lemon-yellow. \$ 2.— each
- 2a **PENQUITE.** A.M. Much overlapping and flat deep clear yellow perianth; the expanded, rather shallow, crown is dark orange-red. A short necked variety on a very strong stem. Well recommended. \$ 4.25 per dozen. \$ 34.— p. 100
- 4a **PINK FANCY.** A.M. 1942. Overlapping and flat pale sulphur-white perianth. The large trumpet-shaped crown is sulphur-yellow and has a fringed, salmon-pink edge. \$ 9.— each
- 4a **PINK GLORY.** Creamy-white perianth and a large, trumpet-shaped, pinkish crown. \$ 25.— each
- 4a **PINK RIM.** Creamy-white perianth. The ivory coloured crown has an almost lilac-pink edge. \$ 12.— each
- 4a **PINK SELECT.** A.M. 1946. Creamy-white perianth and an expanded, salmon-pink, trumpet-shaped crown. A most attractive variety. \$ 18.— each
- 2b **POLINDRA.** F.C.C. The perianth is broad and flat, pure white and of exceptional substance; the large clear yellow crown is of beautiful proportion and slightly serrated. Most attractive. \$ —.80 each
- 2a **PORTHILLY.** F.C.C. Broad and flat, smooth clear yellow perianth and an open frilled cup of most amazingly deep orange-scarlet. \$ 5.— per dozen. \$ 40.— per 100

1c **PRESIDENT LEBRUN.** A.M. 1943. Large and overlapping greenish-white perianth and a large pale primrose-yellow trumpet. Recommended. \$ 1.80 per dozen. \$ 14.50 per 100

2b **PRINCESS BEATRIX.** A.M. Much overlapping and very strong white perianth. Large and spreading, much fringed, orange crown. Strongly recommended. \$ 24.— each

1c **QUEEN OF BICOLORS.** A. M. Flat, much overlapping and large pure white perianth. The very large, rather short trumpet, is clear golden-yellow. Very strong and vigorous. \$ 1.50 per dozen. \$ 12.— per 100

2a **RAMILLIES.** A.M. 1944. A beautiful flower of medium size. Much overlapping and flat clear golden-yellow perianth. The medium sized, spreading crown is bright scarlet. \$ 5.— each

3a **RAPALLO.** A.M. 1943. Strong, very flat, much overlapping and round, clear yellow perianth. The very large and perfectly flat crown is deepest golden-yellow and has a bright red margin. A very fine and unusual type short-necked flower on a strong stem. \$ 6.— each

3a **RED GUARD.** F.C.C. Orange-yellow perianth, richly suffused with red and a small bright scarlet cup. Very charming flower. \$ 6.— per 100

2a **REDMARLEY.** A.M. Slightly pointed yellow perianth; the large and heavily fringed trumpet-shaped crown is intense orange-red throughout. \$ 1.— each

1a **REMBRANDT.** F.C.C. Large golden-yellow of excellent form. \$ 6.— per 100

2a **RIO RITA.** A.M. A magnificent large flower with broad and much overlapping sulphur-yellow perianth; the immense flat crown is orange, and has a nicely frilled edge of deep orange-red. Highly recommended. \$ 5.— per dozen. \$ 40.— per 100

2a **ROSSLARE.** A.M. Broad and much overlapping soft yellow perianth of thick, smooth texture; the large bowl-shaped crown is deep orange-red. Medium late. \$ —.80 each

4a **ROSY SUNRISE.** F.C.C. 1943. Soft creamy-white perianth. The large cream-coloured trumpet-shaped crown is heavily fringed and edged salmon-pink. Large and beautiful. Only a few bulbs available. \$ 100.— each

1b **ROXANE.** F.C.C. Large pure white perianth and a very large and spreading creamy-white trumpet. \$ 1.15 per dozen. \$ 9.— per 100

2b **ROYAL CROWN.** Large sulphur-white perianth. The very large, heavily fringed and spreading crown is soft apricot. \$ 2.50 each
