

# NARCISSI

One of the first, bright harbingers of spring, narcissi naturalize well and are easy to grow. Yielding a brilliant, multiplying profusion of flowers for years on end in fields, woods and gardens, narcissi tolerate a wide range of sunlight from full sun to semi-shade. They do, however, prefer well-draining soil, hate "wet feet" and love to be fed with bulb fertilizer three times a year.

## TRUMPET DAFFODILS

APRIL-FLOWERING. PACKED AND PRICED PER 100.

The most well-known group of narcissi, Trumpet Daffodils naturalize well and have a long blooming season with large, bold flowers. Their flowers have trumpets as long as, or longer than, the flower petals. 18" to 20".



- Passionale:** Delicately scented, its pure white overlapping perianth frames a delicate apricot-pink cup with a slightly ruffled edges. Late April. . . . . (8285) 50 for \$24.50





## TRIANDRUS NARCISSI

These graceful narcissi produce several drooping flowers per stem amidst slender foliage and a light, aromatic scent. They naturalize well in semi-shady areas.

The small dainty flowers of the Species Miniatures represent many varieties of narcissi as they were originally found in the wild hundreds of years ago. These nursery-grown species need some protection from freezing and thawing.

**Angel's Tears:** Also known as Triandrus Albus. Clusters of creamy-white flowers with a reflexing perianth. Great for rockgardens! 7". . . . . (8016) \$31.75

**Canaliculatus:** A delicate miniature with a white, slightly reflexing perianth and a globular yellow cup with three to four flowers per stem and several stems per bulb. Great for rockgardens!. 6". . . . . (8048) \$28.50

**Gracilis:** Deliciously fragrant, this unusual beauty has three to five flowers per stem with a clear yellow perianth and a tiny, yellow-green poeticus-type cup and a deeper yellow corona. One of the last to flower! Performs well in southern states. 10". . . . . (8168) 50 for \$19.75

**Yellow Hoop Petticoat:** Also known as Bulbocodium Conspicuum, this true miniature is golden-yellow and shaped like a petticoat! Great for rockgardens! Very early. 6". . . . . (8496) \$29.75
