



NARCISSI

Narcissi naturalize well and are easy to grow. Yielding a brilliant profusion of flowers in fields, woods and gardens, narcissi tolerate full sun to semi-shade. They do, however, prefer well-draining soil, hate "wet feet" and love to be fed with bulb fertilizer three times a year.

TRUMPET DAFFODILS

APRIL-FLOWERING. PACKED AND PRICED PER 100.

The most well-known group of narcissi, Trumpet Daffodils naturalize well and have a long blooming season with large, bold flowers. Their flowers have trumpets as long as, or longer than, the flower petals. 18" to 20".

- Passionale:** Delicately scented, its pure white overlapping perianth frames a delicate apricot-pink cup with a slightly ruffled edges. Late April. (8357) 50 for \$26.75
- Pink Champion:** A pure white perianth with a pink trumpet. (8403) \$48.50

INDOOR NARCISSI: NEW PRICES!


All indoor narcissi can be supplied from September through February. Blooming in three to five weeks, you can plant these bulbs in soil or pebbles at intervals for delicately-scented flowers all winter. Each bulb will produce several flower-bearing stems. Size: 16/17 cm.



TAZETTA NARCISSI

APRIL-FLOWERING. PACKED AND PRICED PER 100.

A vigorous, freely-flowering strain sometimes called "Polyanthus Narcissi", each bulb bears four to eight clustered flowers on multiple stems. Very fragrant! Ideal for southern areas and good further north with a little winter protection. 18".

Cragford: Large clusters of fragrant blooms with a white perianth and a striking orange cup. Later-flowering. (8078) \$41.75

Minnow: A miniature, white beauty with a yellow cup bearing four to five clustered flowers per stem. Great for rockgardens! (8324) \$24.75

TRIANDRUS NARCISSI

APRIL-FLOWERING. PACKED AND PRICED PER 100, UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED.

These graceful narcissi produce several drooping flowers per stem amidst slender foliage and a light, aromatic scent. They naturalize well in semi-shady areas.

Hawera: A little gem with four to six pendulous lemon-yellow flowers per stem. Very fragrant. Great for rockgardens! 10". (8192) \$27.50


Ice Wings: Sweetly scented, this pure white dazzler has several early-flowering blooms per stem. 12". (8212) 50 for \$23.50

SPECIES MINIATURES

APRIL-FLOWERING. PACKED AND PRICED PER 100, UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED.

The small dainty flowers of the Species Miniatures represent many varieties of narcissi as they were originally found in the wild hundreds of years ago. These nursery-grown species need some protection from freezing and thawing.

- Angel's Tears:** Also known as Triandrus Albus. Clusters of creamy-white flowers with a reflexing perianth. Great for rockgardens! 7". (8023) \$32.75
- Canaliculatus:** A delicate miniature with a white, slightly reflexing perianth and a globular yellow cup with three to four flowers per stem and several stems per bulb. Great for rockgardens! 6". (8056) \$29.50
- Gracilis:** Deliciously fragrant, this unusual beauty has three to five flowers per stem with a clear yellow perianth and a tiny, yellow-green poeticus-type cup and a deeper yellow corona. One of the last to flower! Performs well in southern states. 10". (8181) 50 for \$20.50
- Kenellis:** New! Related to the Yellow Hoop Petticoat, Kenellis has pointed flower petals that open light yellow and turn creamy white. Very early flowering, the cup is white. 6". (8267) 50 for \$28.25
- Yellow Hoop Petticoat:** Also known as Bulbocodium Conspicuum, this true miniature is golden-yellow and shaped like a petticoat! Great for rockgardens! Very early. 6". (8606) \$29.50

SPLIT-CUP NARCISSI
