K970 50 Trumpet Daffodils in 5 varieties **£5.30**

All varieties are packed separately.

For trouble free gardening, there is no doubt that Daffodils are the ideal answer and most varieties will do well with little attention. The mass flowering of Daffodils in the spring is one of the most rewarding events of the year. You will find a most interesting selection among the species and unusual forms. Varieties from 4 inches upwards – of varying flower formation and blooming from the middle of February onwards – dependent on the part of the country in which you live. The coloured illustrations will give you a good idea of the variations available.

Generally speaking all can be naturalised in grass but avoid the Jonquil and Poetaz varieties which prefer a sunny position. It is a good maxim not to remove the foliage until it has died down. However little ill-effect is caused by its removal when the growth decline starts – say mid-June. In beds and borders plant the bulbs 4–6" deep whilst for naturalizing plant them deeper at 6–8".

Varieties we can recommend for indoor cultivation are marked*.

PINK TRUMPET DAFFODILS ☀️ 🌑 + ✂️



MULTIFLOWERED NARCISSI ☀️ 🌑 ✂️ *

Multiflowered Narcissi are also known as Poetaz- and Tazetta Narcissi. These flower when most other Daffodils and Narcissi are over and produce several blooms to each stem. The flowers are sweetly scented and excellent for flower arrangements.

Flowering period: April-May


1091 + ✂️ *Cheerfulness, double blooms, particularly lovely for the garden with scented double white flowers, orange in the centre. Ht. 22". 10 for 66p 50 for £2.95


