### JUDGING SCHOOL IV

School number 4 in the American Daffodil Society training series for daffodil judges will be offered in conjunction with our daffodil show at Heather Farm Garden Center in Walnut Creek. The school begins 9:00 a.m. on Sunday, March 21 downstairs at the Garden Center. Students should study Chapter 3, pp. 10-11, Chapter 7, pp. 31-32, and review Chapters 9 and 11 in the ADS Handbook. For this school, students will have to identify 50 cultivars out of 65 on display. The building will be open at 8:00 a.m. so that students can study the flowers they will have to identify before the lectures start. The fee is \$5. Make checks payable to Northern California Daffodil Society and mail them well ahead of time to the instructor
