

The Anniversary Years Trophy, will honor the 1992- 2012 years with a silver tray from Laura Anne Brooks, the VDS president, in memory of Linda Simon. This collection will consist of 10 standard cultivars hybridized within those years staged in two blocks of five.

It is intended for daffodil programs to garden clubs and general audiences, and would be your first choice for your presentations and programs you are often asked to do. - Would you believe it has been five years since ADS took on the daunting project of having the first 40 years of our *Daffodil Journal* digitized? That DVD is available for \$40.
