Parking Information for Early Arrival on Saturday


The Southeast Regional Daffodil Show is this weekend at Cheekwood. Staging of flowers at Cheekwood will be in the Pottery Studio of the Frist Learning Center from 7 am to 10:15 am on Saturday morning. Judging will start at 10:30.

For early entry on Saturday: Enter Cheekwood from the back entrance on Cheek Road to park near the Frist Learning Center. There is a guard gate and the guard will let you through the gate. There is no need to pay Cheekwood admission if you come early Saturday and enter flowers in the show.

There are two parking lots nearby, one to the left directly after you enter the property is a staff/construction lot. There is a public lot right after it on the left and another smaller lot shortly after it on the right at the Frist Learning Center. Our show will be on the lower level with staging in the Pottery Studio and the show in the Art Studio, both on the same level as the parking lot.

If you come in the main Cheekwood entrance, it is a bit of a walk from there to the Frist Learning Center so just be sure to allow enough time to make it to the show. A ride on a golf cart might be available if you ask a staff member.


