



New Releases 2018

Chetwynd (CP) 1Y-Y Seedling No.375 M/Late

A very smooth round flower of good proportions, one of the latest generation bred by Clive. It is of good size 110 - 115mm and is good for the latter shows.

In time I am sure it will be widely exhibited at these shows **£35.00 each**

Clive Postles (CP) 1W-Y Seedling No. 407 M/ Late

Chosen by Clive himself as one of the best of the batch of Division 1W-Y's

A well balanced flower with large pure white round perianth some 115mm+ width. The corona is long, slightly flared and slightly serrated at the rim which is chrome yellow in colour which gives a tremendous colour contrast with the perianth.

Although it is a good increaser we only have a few bulbs for sale as it was originally planned for release in about 2 years time **£35.00 each**

Idle Valley (CP) 1Y-O Seedling No. 348 Mid

Very smooth ace of spades yellow perianth 115-120mm in size, slightly flared corona, pale orange in colour. Good collection flower **£30.00 each**

Ingham Nook (CP) 4Y-O Seedling No. 293 Mid

Best Division 4 at the Daffodil Society show in 2017. Large round double which measures 108-110mm. The perianth segments are layer on layer which shows a full profile. **£35.00 each**

Wendy Gillings (CP) 3Y-R Seedling No. 285 M/Late

Named after The Daffodil Society's Membership Secretary, much admired in the seedling beds by her husband Richard. A very colourful flower with good size 115mm plus. Very useful for late shows, also is excellent for collection classes giving a good impact. **£35.00 each**

Clive Postles Varieties

Amber Valley (CP) 1Y-Y Seedling No. 405 M/Late

A very round dark yellow super smooth perianth with an amber coloured corona which is very round and slightly flared, 110mm-115mm in diameter. One of the next generation bred out of Ombersley which has great potential as a show flower and I am sure it will find its place in the top Division 1's being shown in years to come.

Aslockton (CP) 4Y-0 Mid

One of many superb exhibition doubles bred by Clive which will make a great impact on the show bench and is also suitable for garden display with a short neck and a long strong stem. The broad petal back is fronted by regular layers of canary yellow petaloids of decreasing size towards the centre which are interspersed with short orange coronal segments.

Aston Heath (CP) 1 Y-O Seedling No. 308 E/Mid

One of our trumpet daffodil range, a round large 110mm round perianth mid yellow in colour, with a bright orange cup,

Astrid's Memory (CP) 3W-Y Seedling No. 3-30-89 Mid/Late

Still the finest daffodil I have ever seen, just wonderful! Starting to establish itself as one of the best Division 3's ever bred. Mid season flowering.

Barbara Ann (CP) 2W-W Seedling No.895 Mid

An extremely large flower with 125mm pure white round perianth, and pure white corona, which expands slightly to the serrated rim. On its first outing it was in the winning collection of six cultivars, exhibited by my good friend Jeff English. An absolute must for the serious Exhibitor

Beauvale (CP) 3 Y-YO Seedling 378 Mid /Late

One of Clive's colourful division 3's, with a 108mm round canary yellow perianth in colour which has a short disc shaped cup, yellow at the base shading down to an orange rim. This should make a good exhibition flower.

Benjamin (CP) 1W-W Seedling No.2-91 Mid

One of our newer white trumpet daffodils, 110mm pure white perianth with a true trumpet corona, good healthy plant and bulb. A useful addition to this division.

Bentley Brook (CP) 1Y-Y Seedling 326 Mid/Late

Bred with Ombersley in its parentage, this large all yellow trumpet daffodil will give that wow factor to any exhibit. The perianth is 115-120mm flat with a good overlap, the corona is true trumpet in length with a slight flare. We rate this one as a top exhibition flower. **£27.50 each**

Birky (CP) 2W-P Seedling No 109-19-88 Mid

This flower is just wonderful as one would expect with its very special name! Superb in all departments. Breeding seedling x Ben Aligin. Mid season **£6.50 each**

Bramcote (CP) 1Y-Y Seedling No. 334 Mid/Late

As one of the next generation of Clive's Division 1Y-Y seedlings, this variety has the potential of becoming a winning variety replacing Ombersley. A flower of immense size 120-125mm, very round in appearance with a super smooth perianth and very round corona. It has already been shown with a win in the collection classes at Warwick and was part of the open 12 cultivars winning exhibit at the RHS in 2012 **£12.50 each**

Bramcote Daybreak (CP) 1W-Y Seedling No.365 Mid

Winner of the 1W-Y single bloom class at the 2012 RHS Main Show.

This cultivar is one of quite a few seedlings from this division, which are a welcome improvement on the current cultivars available. Not only the size of the flower which measures 125mm plus, the colour contrast from the poet white perianth to the chrome yellow of the corona is outstanding. This flower oozes pure quality. As this variety was released early there are still only a few available **£17.50 each**

Bramcote Gem (CP) 1W-Y Seedling 307 Mid

After releasing this much awaited seedling, on its first outing it attained Best Division 1, Best Seedling under number and Best in Show at the RHS 2012 Main Competition. It has a large pure white perianth 120-125mm and a long slightly tapered bright yellow trumpet. **£35.00 each**

Bramcote Star (CP) 2Y-O Seedling No 335 M/Late

A large balanced flower 108-110mm with mid yellow ace of spades perianth which is very smooth. Corona is straight with a slight flare at the rim which is a bright orange colour. An excellent show flower. **£7.50 each**

Bramcote Sunrise (CP) 2Y-O Seedling No. 38-91 M/Late

A large balanced flower 108-110mm with mid yellow ace of spades perianth segments and a bright orange corona **£7.50 each**

Bramcote Village (CP) 2Y-YO Seedling No. 1-39-90 M/Late

A variety that is much needed as its natural flowering time is mid to late season which for a Y-O is rare. The blooms are a good size measuring 108-110mm, the colour contrast from golden yellow perianth to bright orange corona is quite defined with no staining. The corona is sun and wind proof and shows no signs of burning. It is very round and flared and will do well on the show bench

Bramley Vale 1W-Y Seedling No. 332 M/Late

Pure white 115mm round perianth, the corona has a quite distinct contrast of bright deep yellow with expanded frilled rim.

Castle Howard 1W-W Mid

A large white from Clive 114mm. Very few for sale.

Chee Dale (CP) 4W-Y Seedling No. 702 Mid

Named after a Derbyshire dale near to where Roger spent his childhood summer holidays, this will be a winner and a useful addition to this division. 108-110mm in size with good interlacing of white and yellow petaloids producing a striking contrast, strong stem and neck

Church Wilne (CP) 4Y-O Seedling 16-1 Early/Mid

Good for pot and ground cultivation, part of the winning 'English Award' at the World Convention in 2016 in Saint Louis. Bright yellow perianth interlaced with orange petaloids which build into a well balanced double. 105mm in size

Coplow Dale (CP) 1W-Y Seedling 350 Mid /Late

One of Clive's colourful Division 1's, with a 112mm round perianth pure white, corona is long with a slight flare. We think this will have a place on the show bench as an exhibition flower.

Coughton Court (CP) 1W-Y Seedling No 321. Mid

Named after the ancestral home of the Throckmorton Family. A large well balanced flower which has an ace of spades pure white perianth measuring 115-120mm, the corona is lemon in colour, slightly flared with a rolled rim

Crowndale (CP) 4 Y-O Mid

Considered the best yellow double for exhibition with a proven show record of wins. Only a few for sale this year.

Desert Quest (CP) 2Y-O Seedling 1-38-91 Mid

First class show flower deep yellow, roundish in shape. The corona is bowl shaped and solid orange to the base. Breeding seedlings on both sides

Dream Team (CP) 4Y-Y Seedling 1-37-47 Mid

In the transfer from Clive to myself the stock became somewhat depleted and it has taken many years to build it up again. On the occasions it has been seen on the show bench it has achieved high praise and is a worthy addition to this division and I believe it will do well. 100-105mm in size. Only a few for sale

Ednaston (CP) 3W-GYO Seedling No. 1-13-91 Late

This very colourful, non-predominant Division 3, with the attributes of a poet 108-110mm. Pure sparkling white flat smooth perianth, the corona is flat, green at the base with three quarters of its length yellow with a bright orange rim. A good collection exhibition flower

Emma-Jane (CP) 2W-Y Seedling No 341 Mid

Named after the daughter of very close friends. The very smooth ace of spades perianth is pure white measuring 110-112mm, the corona is round and slightly flared. The colour of the corona is deceptive at first as it starts off orange in colour but as the bloom matures it changes to a very pleasing dark yellow/orange, giving a very distinctive contrast

Ever so Sweet (CP) 3W-WWP Seedling No 351 M/Late

This cultivar has a very rare colour combination for this Division. The perianth forms a very smooth ace of spades which are pure white. 108-110mm diameter which gives a perfect foil to the slightly flared round corona which has a wide band of pink at its rim. A good collection flower.

Felley Priory (CP) 2Y-Y Seedling 436 Mid/L

Named after a local Nottinghamshire landmark which is known for its planting of all types of spring flowers. A large well proportioned quality perianth, 110mm with slightly flared corona. A good addition to this section

First Team (CP) 4Y-O Seedling 1-5-89 Early/Mid

Almost perfect double having 4 complete whorls of yellow interspersed with orange petaloids. Very neat. Early season.

Flor-D'Luna (CP) 2Y-W Seedling No. 1-51-93 Mid

Not as large as its famous parent but a wonderful colour contrast.

The mid yellow perianth is very smooth and unfading. The corona changes to snow white after just a few days.

Golden Alpha (CP) 1Y-Y Early.

The very large deep yellow perianth is a double triangle shape and very smooth.

A very round perianth 115mm wide with a 42mm long cylindrical corona, slightly flared. Has won many awards




Jim Pearce (CP) 2W-O Seedling No 2-8-91 Late




