Some of the seedlings have been down more than one year and bulbs may be odd shaped and slightly rougher appearing than usual. A few are limited supply.

**HYBRIDIZER'S SEEDLING COLLECTION**

The following collection of seedlings may be of interest for hybridizing or for general appeal.

- TEH7/2** (Ever Pink x Magician) 2W-P Deep red pink with heavy substance. Relatively small flower, it may be useful for hybridizing for deeper color in smaller flowers. It's heavy substance and bright color gives it garden appeal. **02-422**
- TEH41/2** (Iroquois x At Dawning) 2W-O Only lacks 3 mm of being a trumpet, this flower strongly resembles At Dawning, but with a bright orange corona here. A flower of interest in its own right, as well as its obvious breeding potential. **02-751**
- TEH53/11** (Jetfire x Gypsy) Possessing a flat perianth, the intermediate size makes it desirable for show. Seems to set seed quite readily here and may be useful for breeding color into smaller flowers. **06-913**
- VH3/1** (At Dawning x Pink Silk) A number of visitors have noticed the unusual color. Its long pink trumpet is rimmed with amber soon after it opens; later it loses the amber and is a 1W-P **01-828**
- VH9/1** (Glenfarclas x LEJ21/1 {Rima x Graduation}) Often, measuring 1W-O, this won the competition at the 2000 convention in Portland. Corona is variable in length; some years, it measures less than trumpet here. Has a rather long neck, but quite spectacular when it first opens, may be useful. Limited supply. **02-623**

**WH27 (Lorikeet x Magician)**

These seedlings may be useful for hybridizing--all Division 2, some with more deep pink in the cup and pink underlay in the perianth. Rather large prominent cups with frills and flange. Relatively short strong stems and deep color. Some may be named in the future.

**WH27/3** Creamy lemon smooth broad perianth; apricot-pink cylindrical corona much expanded and heavily ruffled with deeper pink at the rim.

**WH27/6** Pale lemon broadly ovate perianth, at times heavily suffused with pink. Rosy pink corona with narrower base. Very showy and of reasonable form.

**WH27/7** Creamy lemon perianth, less yellow than Color Magic; funnel shaped corona of deep apricot pink, heavily ruffled at the rim.

### GREEN EYED JONQUILS Y128 (Cedar Hills x N. jonquilla)

Deep green eyes on these delightful yellow jonquils (all classified as Division 7), provide interest for the very end of the season. Occasionally, in very hot late springs, the buds may blast, so may be a problem in some climates. A couple of these were displayed in Cincinnati. Mid yellow perianths which sometimes roll a bit; deep green eyes with remainder of cup a deeper more golden yellow. Light fragrance and tall stems.

**Y128/2** Cup shaped corona with slight ruffle at rim; relatively flat perianth. 1-2 per stem. Generally, best formed.

**Y128/5** Flatter, saucer shaped coronas; green eye becomes tan at maturity; most have 1 per stem.

**Y128/6** Opening with green eye and green mid-zone in cup. Generally 2-3 per stem.

### RED PINK SEEDLINGS--VH20

**VH20** is a cross between Pink Valentine x Pink Flame and a wide range of intense colors and forms have resulted. Pinkish lavender undertones to tomato red are present and in most cases, the perianths are very white. From this cross, Firestar, Ruby Romance and Rubystar have been named. Similar collections have been offered in the past. A picture of some of the VH20 seedlings is on page 14 in the 2002 catalog.

### INDIVIDUAL SEEDLINGS (for Show and Garden)

**UH71/1** 2W-W (Panache seedling x Clearwater) Beautifully smooth large white, capable of show and making a dazzling display in the garden. Broad, flat perianth; long corona with narrow base. **02-649** \$10.00 ea.

**2V4/2** 2O-R (Red Aria x Sabine Hay) A sibling to Red Diamond, this one blooms late in the season, making a bright showing of color. Broad perianth of golden yellow, deepening in color to coppery orange if protected from the sun. Bowl shaped corona, wavy at the edge. Dual purpose for show and cutting. **02-527** \$7.00 ea.

**2T21/2** 11aW-P (Mission Impossible x Cool Flame seedling) Ovate white perianth complements a most striking pink split corona, which is very flat, but heavily ruffled at the rim. Heavy substance, immediately noticeable, lends extra long life to the flower. **11-164** \$3.00 ea.;(\$7.50 per 3);(\$12.00 per 6).

### NAMED CULTIVARS

**Laser** (Mitsch) 2W-R Large broad white perianth with intense red bowl-shaped corona, edged with even deeper red. One of our earlier seedlings to actually approach red in our climate. **02-949** \$20.00 ea.

**Moon Moth** (Helen Link) 5W-Y Well formed slightly reflexing white perianth with bowl shaped expanded corona; usually 2-3 per stem. Very limited supply. **05-990** \$15.00 ea.

**Parnell's Knob** (Dr. Wm. Bender) 1Y-Y Smooth, broad flat perianth of vivid yellow; funnel shaped trumpet, slightly darker. Has won Gold at a National show. **01-127** \$17.00 ea.

**Prism** (Mitsch) 2Y-Y (Aircastle x Cool Flame) Broad lemon yellow perianth; saucer shaped corona of a deeper shade. **02-302** \$4.00 ea.

**Radiant Gem** (Mitsch) 8Y-R Sibling to Hoopoe and Falconet, this is distinct in color, with orange red bowl-shaped coronas and deep golden yellow perianths. **08-309** \$10.00 ea.

**Shearwater** (Mitsch) 2W-WWY Large broad perianth opens white, becoming ivory white; bowl shaped corona opens pale lemon, becoming nearly white with lemon rim. **02-325** \$5.00 ea.

**Tutu** (Helen Link) 5W-W Slightly reflexed overlapping white perianth; nearly disc-shaped white corona. Distinctive. Very limited supply. **05-502** \$15.00 ea.

**Whip-poor-will** (Helen Link) 6Y-Y Smooth clear yellow throughout, somewhat reflexed petals and tubular corona. Faces up more than most 6's. **06-920** \$5.00 ea.
