SHOW FLOWERS

Carib Gipsy (Pearson) 2Y-WWY Greenish lemon yellow when opening, the broad smooth perianth deepening and the cylindrical corona becoming white with gold rim. **02-193** \$7.00 ea.

Classic Delight (Frey) 2YYW-GOO Very well formed, opens clear yellow, the corona deepening to apricot with green eye, a halo on the perianth. **02-474** \$10.00 each.

Coldbrook (Bender) 2Y-W Well formed broad lemon perianth with relatively short, white saucer shaped corona. **02-378** \$8.00 each

Easter Surprise (Frey) 2W-GPP Well formed large white perianth; long salmon pink corona with green eye. **02-931** \$6.00 each.

Goff's Caye (Pearson) 2YYW-W Opens lemon yellow the broad, smooth perianth deepens, while funnel shaped corona with ruffled border, turns white. Consistent. **02-492** \$7.00 each.

Gull (Mitsch) 2W-W Very smooth all white with mid-length corona. Limited supply. **02-201** \$7.00 ea.

Lemon Cooler (M. Yerger) 9W-GYO Well formed broadly ovate poet-white perianth; corona with green eye, bright yellow zone and narrow band of red orange, frilled at border. A welcome addition to the poets. **09-420** \$19.00 each.

Limey Circle (Eve Robertson) 3W-WWY Broad white perianth; small yellow corona with greenish yellow rim. **03-405** \$10.00 each.

Moonflight (Mitsch) 4Y-Y Well formed double with broad lemon perianth and deeper yellow corona segments arranged symmetrically. **04-252** \$6.00 each.

Queen City (Mitsch) 2W-P Mid-length slightly ruffled cup of intense red pink with a well formed spade shaped pure white perianth. **02-566** \$5.00 each.

Tuscarora (Bender) 1Y-Y Very broadly ovate bright greenish yellow perianth; vivid yellow cylindrical narrow trumpet, slightly expanded at the mouth. Excellent form. **01-438** \$20.00 each.

Xunantunich (Pearson) 2YYW-WWY Deep lemon yellow perianth with prominent white halo, the long cylindrical corona becomes creamy white with deep lemon rim. **02-194** \$5.00 each.

FOR THE GARDEN

Anatolia (Mitsch) 2YYW-Y Large, smooth, well formed flower of luminous lemon with a white halo, suitable for garden or show. Vigorous; heavy substance. **02-781** \$5.00 each.

Carolina Sunset (Eve Robertson) 2Y-O Rob. #539. This is one of Eve's originations with reports that it does well in the climatic conditions of the South. It has done very well here, and is planned for listing in the 2004 catalog. Ovate bright yellow perianth with mid-orange funnel-shaped corona, frilled at the edge. A fine flower for the garden. **02-664** \$7.00 ea.

Meadow Lake (Havens) 1Y-Y One of the earliest flowers to bloom here. Lemony yellow ovate perianth with trumpet of the same color. **02-239** \$8.00 each.

Pink Bomb (Mitsch) 2W-PPR White perianth with expanded cup which opens bright yellow with red rim, the inner zones turning bright pink in our climate. **02-283** \$6.00 each.

SEEDLING COLLECTIONS for the GARDEN

The interest in the seedling collections last year, was greatly appreciated and we would like to offer the following again, at this time.

WH27 (LoriKeet x Magician)

These seedlings may be useful for hybridizing—all Division 2, some with more deep pink in the cup and pink underlay in the perianth. Rather large prominent cups with frills and flange. Relatively short strong stems and deep color. Some may be named in the future.

WH27/3 Creamy lemon smooth broad perianth; apricot-pink ruffled cylindrical corona, deeper pink at rim.

WH27/6 Pale lemon broad perianth, at times heavily suffused with pink. Rosy pink corona with narrower base.

WH27/7 Creamy lemon perianth; funnel shaped corona of deep apricot pink, heavily ruffled at the rim.

Green Eyed Jonquils Y128 (Cedar Hills x N. jonquilla)

Deep green eyes (reminiscent of their pollen parent) on these delightful yellow jonquils (all classified as Division 7), bloom at the very end of the season. Occasionally, in very hot late springs, the buds may blast, so may be a problem in some climates. Mid-yellow perianths sometimes roll a bit; intense green eyes in deep yellow coronas. Light fragrance and tall stems.

Y128/2 Cup shaped corona with slight ruffle at rim; relatively flat perianth. 1-2 per stem.

Y128/5 Flatter, saucer shaped coronas; green eye becomes tan at maturity; most have 1 per stem.

Y128/6 Opening with green eye and green mid-zone in cup. Generally 2-3 per stem.
