

Box lunches provided. Remember you chose A, B, or C bus? The purpose of these options is twofold: 1) to accommodate, at least somewhat, the range of time people might wish to spend looking at flowers; and 2) Rex Hill Vineyards (site of picnic area for lunch) cannot handle the whole group at once. Based on your selections, there are 2 A's, 2 B's and 3 C's. However, some adjustments may be needed because buddies are expected to accompany their respective newbies on the outbound bus, and some buses may be booked beyond capacity. Please try to be flexible and just keep smiling, or tour coordinator Jeanie Driver may start tearing out her hair!

At each location your bus director will give each of you a fresh pair of large, one-sizefits-all heavy plastic overboots with built-in ties. Please follow the printed instructions to make proper use of the ties. These will keep your shoes, socks and cuffs free of mud and will help prevent the introduction of disease organisms and pests into our fields from your footgear. Please dispose of these boots properly when reboarding your bus. Your cooperation is appreciated.

Remember you're going on the sternwheeler river cruise before dinner, so whatever you wear on the bus, will probably be appropriate for the rest of the evening's activities.

Of course we all like to catch up with old friends from far and near, but get to know some new folks, and help turn a newbie into a future daffbuddy!

The Daffodil Boutique

Where else in the world could you find so much narcissiana in one place? Nancy Cameron and her committee have beaten the bushes to bring you an unparalleled collection of all things daffodil. Looking for something practical to make your gardening or flower showing a bit better or easier? The perfect gift for someone who loves daffodils as much as you? A unique memento of the World Convention to add to your collection.? It's all here, so you might as well just surrender to that urge to spring for that item you know you can't live without.

The World Daffodil Convention Postal Station

Portland's Postmaster has authorized the creation and use of a special commemorative postal cancellation, available only during this convention and for a very limited period thereafter, to satisfy the requests of stamp and cover collectors. This is your opportunity to create genuine collector's items for yourself and to share with your daffodil friends and philatelic friends all over the world. The design was created by **Cassandra Hackworth**, a student at Amity High School.

Simply for the price of first-class or air mail postage you get your own little piece of daffodil history, and a very attractive bit of graphic art as well. The boutique right next door has souvenir envelopes with the WDC2K logo for sale, or you can use whatever you like as long as it has the proper postage affixed. The stations hours are limited to Friday and Saturday afternoons, however, so you'll have to make a concerted effort if you want to mail a letter with the special postmark on those days. If you're unable to get there yourself, ask someone to do it for you!

You can still get the cancellation for collectible purposes until the end of April by sending your cover to the Portland Postmaster. See Bill Tribe for further information.

About that guy with the videocamera...

Portland radio reporter Nevill Eschen has been commissioned by the BBC to get convention audio for the daffodil program in a series on individual flowers and their devotees. Don't be shy — after all, you're being asked to talk about daffodils! Make sure the producer knows she sent Nevill to the right place.

Silence may be golden, but money talks.

On Friday and Saturday, on display near the boutique — and following you into dinner each night are a number of exquisite works of daffodil art for sale by silent auction.

Artist and narcissophile Bill Gould of Winston Salem, North Carolina has donated three new works to tempt you. Each is an original colored pencil drawing, matted and framed.: "Intrigue", 16"x19" vertical; "Early Step Toward a Pink Perianth", 17-1/2"x20", vertical; and "Akepa Seedling, 18-1/2"x21", horizontal. Minimum opening bid on each is \$450.00.

In addition, there are six individual prints from the F.W. Burbridge and J.G Baker book "The Narcissus History and Culture" These plates are eagerly sought by collectors of historical botanical art. Opening bid for each is \$50.00. Take a look and ponder an investment in fine art. Bidding will close around 8:00 pm on Saturday, and our new ADS President, Peg Newill will announce the results.

Who's Talking Now?

The Oregon Daffodil Society and American Daffodil Society are privileged to bring these wellknown "daffodil personalities" to Portland from 3 continents for WDC2K — to educate and entertain us, and to add their personal touch to our own efforts. We thank them for accepting our invitation to speak to us.

JOHN W. BLANCHARD comes to us from Dorset, England, where he has followed the path of his father, both professionally as a solicitor and in his lifelong fascination with the genus *Narcissus*. An author, lecturer, hybridizer, and field researcher, John is an internationally respected authority on daffodils, particularly in the area of wild species and natural hybrid daffodils. He has traveled extensively in search of wild daffodils in France, Spain, Portugal, and Morocco, and he has added greatly to our understanding of *Narcissus*. John has served on the Royal Horticultural Society (RHS) Council, and he has been a member or chairman of virtually every important RHS committee relating to daffodils for many years. Both the RHS and ADS have recognized the contributions of John Blanchard to botanical knowledge by awarding him their highest honors.

Oregon's own ELISE HAVENS says she thinks "most people know more than they care to" about her, so she was not particularly generous with the biographical details. As one of the daughters of America's premier daffodil breeder, Grant Mitsch, one might say Elise was "born with a golden daffodil in her mouth", destined to continue her father's legacy. She has been hybridizing for more than half of the family business' 73 years. After careers in computer programming analysis and teaching respectively, she and husband Dick purchased her parents' business after their 50th year, and they have been full-time daffodil growers since 1978.

JOHN PEARSON traces his own horticultural heritage to his family's centuries-old business in his Nottinghamshire, England birthplace. He grew up studying natural sciences and hunting for plants in the Northamptonshire countryside, and embarked on his own horticultural career by working for a year with Guy Wilson in Northern Ireland in preparation for study at Reading University. Stricken with "yellow fever", he stayed another year with Guy Wilson, then joined Kate Reade in the establishment of Carncairn Daffodils. As growing daffodils did not generate sufficient income for the family he was about to start with Rosemary in 1961, John re-entered military service but continued daffodil hybridizing throughout his 20-year career as a British Army Paymaster, which included tours of duty in Germany, Singapore and Belize. He resigned his commission in 1982 and moved to Hofflands in Essex, where he lives and grows daffodils today. His first daffodil registrations (1987) included 'Altun Ha', 'Carib Gipsy', 'Hot Gossip' and ' Stoke Charity', and Hofflands Daffodils has continued to grow and thrive there since its incepton the following year.

LESLEY RAMSAY, our final "yellow fever" victim, is a long-time player on the New Zealand daffodil scene, usually forgoing the spotlight (at least on this side of the Pacific) in favor of husband Peter. We are pleased to present Lesley in her debut as an ADS convention speaker. She is a member and past president of the Northern Daffodil Club and a member of the National Executive of the National Daffodil Society of New Zealand. As a partner in Koanga Daffodils, and Senior National Judge, she is an "experienced stager, exhibitor, lifter, cleaner, storer and planter of daffodil bulbs in all weather conditions." Lesley also expresses an irrational fear of some imaginary character called "Daffman."... hmmmm...

Where do You Think You're Going?

Saturday, April 1

Mitsch Daffodils, Hubbard, Oregon

A trip to Dick and Elise Havens' farm shows why Oregon is the Mecca for serious narcissophiles throughout the world. Here the Havens have been making their own mark, building on the breeding progress of Elise' world-renowned father, Grant A. Mitsch. The fertile soils of the Willamette Valley combine with abundant rainfall and generally moderate winters to create nearly ideal conditions for growing healthy daffodils. See it all!

Cherry Creek Daffodils, Sherwood, Oregon

Steve and Heather Vinisky moved their family and their daffodils here from California a few years ago, and it appears Steve has spent every waking hour and then some expanding and improving his plantings of daffodils and countless other species of plants. Three years ago, he made the leap from passionate hobbyist to commercial grower and hybridizer. Perched in the foothills at an elevation of 1000 ft, the Viniskys enjoy a stunning vista of the Willamette Valley and snow-covered Mt Hood in the distance. A great place to visit and spend some time with someone who really knows his daffodils

Sunday, April 2

Oregon Trail Daffodils and Bonnie Brae Gardens, Corbett, Oregon

Only minutes apart but separated by hundreds of vertical feet, these two farms in the area near the Columbia River Gorge share a common origin in the life work of Murray Evans, Oregon's other world class breeder of exceptional daffodils. Jeanie and Frank Driver (Bonnie Brae) took over a number of Murray's stocks about 15 years ago., including miniatures and intermediates. In the intervening years, Jeanie has acquired and offered many other intermediates for sale in the Bonnie Brae catalog. With the publication of their 2000 catalog, Jeanie and Frank announced their retirement from commercial daffodil activity, and freed from the demands of a business enterprise, they will continue to enjoy their gardens and their lovely country setting. A visit to Frank and Jeanie's place always lifts one's spirits.

Bill and Diane Tribe (she's Murray Evans' neice) assumed the bulk of the Evans bulbs and the many cultivars and seedlings grown by Murray for Bill Pannill and began Oregon Trail Daffodils in 1989. Their relationship with Bill Pannill continues with Bill's annual visits to Oregon in the season, and with shipments of seeds and bulbs between Virginia and Oregon. Some of the earliest Oregon Trail breeding produced some very exciting seedlings, a few of which are about ready to be put on the market. A recent addition to the OTD stable is the series of golden yellow trumpets and near-trumpets bred by Henry Hartmann of New Jersey, and soon to offered for sale. Many have been included in winning collections entered in national shows in the past few years.
