And so we close another season and I'll need my anti-depressants again after Yellow Fever is gone. :-)

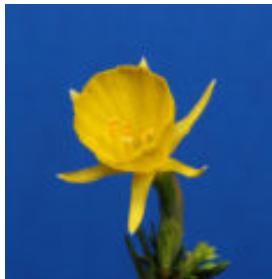

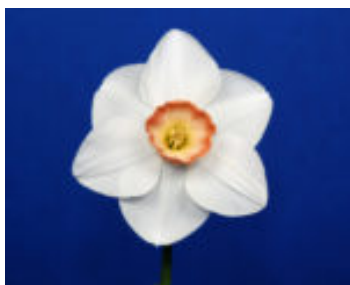

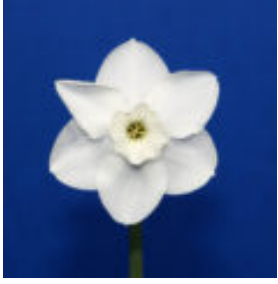
