## **Youth Classes**

In an effort to encourage more youth exhibiting at daffodil shows, the ADS has created a few new classes. Some shows will be adding them to their schedules. Look at your show schedule to see if your area show is offering them.

The first is the Brooke Ager Challenge Class. ADS Youth Committee will select a cultivar each year and supply that cultivar to all current ADS youth members. Bulbs will be sent in the fall. At the spring show any youth (not just ADS members) can bring in a bloom of that cultivar to exhibit. Pink Charm was selected this past fall and was sent to all youth members.
