Lastly, as we wait for the magical arrival of our daffodil blooms, I look forward to seeing you this spring!



9:45 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. – Short Break

10:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. – Part 1B-Daffodil Anatomy (Chapter 1), Six Judging Criteria (Chapter 9, pp. 89-98, 117-119), Ethics and Guidelines for Judges (pp. 106 -110 and 112-113).

11:00 a.m. to 12:45 p.m. – Part 1 C - Positive Judging (p.89) and Practice Placement and Point Scoring. This ends the program for those auditing and refreshing.
