NEWER NAMED CULTIVARS

- A CAPPELLA** 2W-P LM 16" (Precedent x Magician) TT10/2A One of the few selections from this cross which is not red-pink, the luscious color of rich rosy pink is just as inviting. Well formed having broad white perianth segments and straight, slightly expanded cup with a formal bit of frill at the margin, not as expanded as its sibling Amadeus. Excellent increaser with vigorous health. **02-100** \$15.00 each.
- BEAUTIFUL MUSIC** 3W-GYO L 18" (Impala x Green Hills) 2P59/2. Large rounded flower with broad perianth segments, slightly pointed. Small spreading corona with green eye, creamy yellow midsection and orange wire rim. Previously offered. **03-108** \$6.00 each.
- PARTY GIRL** (David Sheppard) 4W-YYP L 17" A very full double with broad white segments, the corona segments being creamy yellow with pink rim. Strong stems, supporting the large flowers in the garden; well formed and symmetrical, capable for show. **04-576** \$10.00 each.
- ROMAN RIM** 2W-WWP M (Easter Moon x Rubythroat) 2P9/3. Sculpted marble comes to mind when viewing this massive yet refined flower with its heavy substance and well balanced form. Large rounded white perianth segments and bowl shaped white corona wavy at the edge, with a distinct rim of rose pink, best if picked soon after opening. **02-319** \$12.00 each.
- TRUMPETER SWAN** 1W-P EM (Pink Satin sib x Pink Silk) TEH38/7. Very well formed intense pink trumpet with broad flat white perianth of heavy substance. Previously offered. **01-713** \$6.00 each.

PINK SEEDLING COLLECTION

TT10 – Precedent x Magician

Most of the seedlings selected from this cross are deep red pink; three of those below are deeply colored, and one is clear mid pink. All are excellent flowers for the garden.

TT10/1 Tall flower with white perianth and expanded deep red pink corona.

TT10/10 Large broad white perianth with brilliant showy corona of deep apricot color, expanded and frilled at the margin.

TT10/12 Beautiful light pink corona with rather informal white perianth; tall and vigorous.

TT10/20 Quite well formed, broad white perianth with deep red pink expanded corona.

DISQUIET 1Y-Y L 19" Deep golden yellow trumpet. A double triangular perianth of thick broadly ovate petals. Cylindrical trumpet is rolled at its end. **01-984** \$18.00 each.

MISQUOTE 1Y-Y E 15" Very consistent smooth flower with broad shovel shaped petals and narrow tubular plain trumpet. Frequent show winner. **01-836** \$56.00 each.

NYNJA 2Y-Y M 16" Very consistent smooth flower. Plane rounded perianth of very broad ovate petals slightly lighter lemon colored than the funnel shaped straight plain trumpet. Every flower show quality. Grand Champion Australian Championships 1999. **02-838** \$21.00 each.

WHITES:

DELEENA 2W-W LM 15" Glistening white rounded perianth of smooth thick very ovate petals that overlap at the back. Long funnel shaped corona is slightly creamy and has a slight roll. **02-467** \$20.00 each.

MIRRABOOKA 2W-W EM 18" Vigorous and healthy white for show. Flat double triangular perianth of very broadly ovate back petals and ovate minor petals. Funnel shaped three quarter length cup, with a yellowish-green eye has a flared rim. **02-835** \$20.00 each.

QUARK 1W-W EM 18" Refined flower for show. Petals are thick, smooth and broadly ovate. Rather plain cylindrical trumpet is of good proportion and has a plain straight rim. **01-973** \$14.00 each.

All are well formed with flat ovate smooth perianths of show quality and are possible intermediates. Please note the same collection was offered in 1999.

- Y99/1** sharply contrasted reverse bicolor
- Y99/3** lemon perianth with white halo; buff corona
- Y99/5** perianth heavily suffused orange; deep orange corona (has won a Rose Ribbon)
- Y99/6** All golden yellow.
