**It will start on time.**

**8:00 a.m. to 9 a.m.** - Sign in. Cultivars for ID test available for study.

**9 a.m. to 9:45 a.m.** Part 2A - Protecting blooms advancing or retarding bloom, controlling stem length, cutting, conditioning, grooming blooms, transporting blooms by auto and by air, and entering the show. *Janet Hickman*

**9:45 a.m. to 10:00 a.m.** – Short Break

**10:00 a.m. to 11:15 a.m.** – Part 2 B - ADS awards guidelines for judges choosing the championships, and etiquette and ethics for judges. *Becky Fox Matthews*

**11:15 a.m. to 11:25 a.m.** - Stretch

**11:25 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.** –Part 2C - Judging three-of-a-kind entries, judging miniatures and species with illustrative slides. Practice point scoring of species, miniatures and three-of-a-kind entries. (1 ½ hours) *Keith Kridler*

This ends the program for those auditing and refreshing.

**1:00 p.m. to 1:30 p.m.** – Lunch and Study Time

**1:30 p.m.** – Four tests: I.D. of cultivars by name, division and color code of perianth, Part 2A, Part 2B and 2C. Once the written testing has begun, the student may not leave the room.

**Wednesday, April 1<sup>st</sup>, 5 p.m. to 7 p.m.** the 35 daffodils for the I.D. test tagged with their name, division and color code will be available for study at Brent and Becky's Bulbs.

### Requirements to be eligible to take the test in Judging School 2

1. Membership in the American Daffodil Society. (Available from the American Daffodil Society webstore - [www.daffodilusastore.org](http://www.daffodilusastore.org))
2. Have the *ADS Handbook for Growing, Exhibiting and Judging Daffodils*. Purchase ASAP in order to have adequate study time. \* You will need to cover the reading assignments in advance.

While ADS membership is not a requirement for auditing, it is invaluable to daffodil growers. You will be sent **A STUDY OUTLINE** when your registration is received.
