

'*Gambas*', a miniature registered by Alec Gray in 1964, usually starts the blooming season with perfectly formed 1 Y-Y blooms. They are a sight to behold! So small, yet the frilly edge of the corona adds texture to the form and substance of the blooms. Soon to follow will be N. obvallaris, a very old pseudo narcissus that

continues to impress me with its pointed perianth and rounded corona. From those two beginning cultivars my garden slowly blossoms into daffodil season with a multitude of blooms until the end of April.
