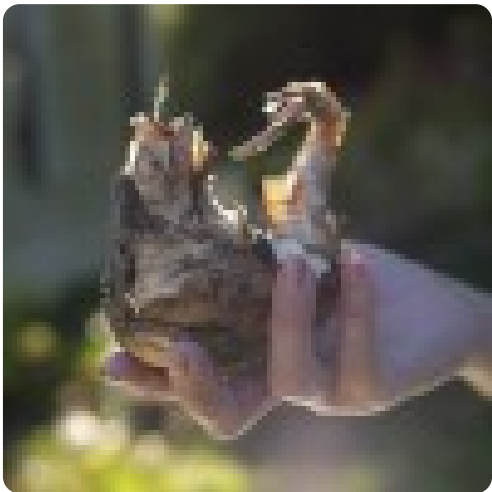

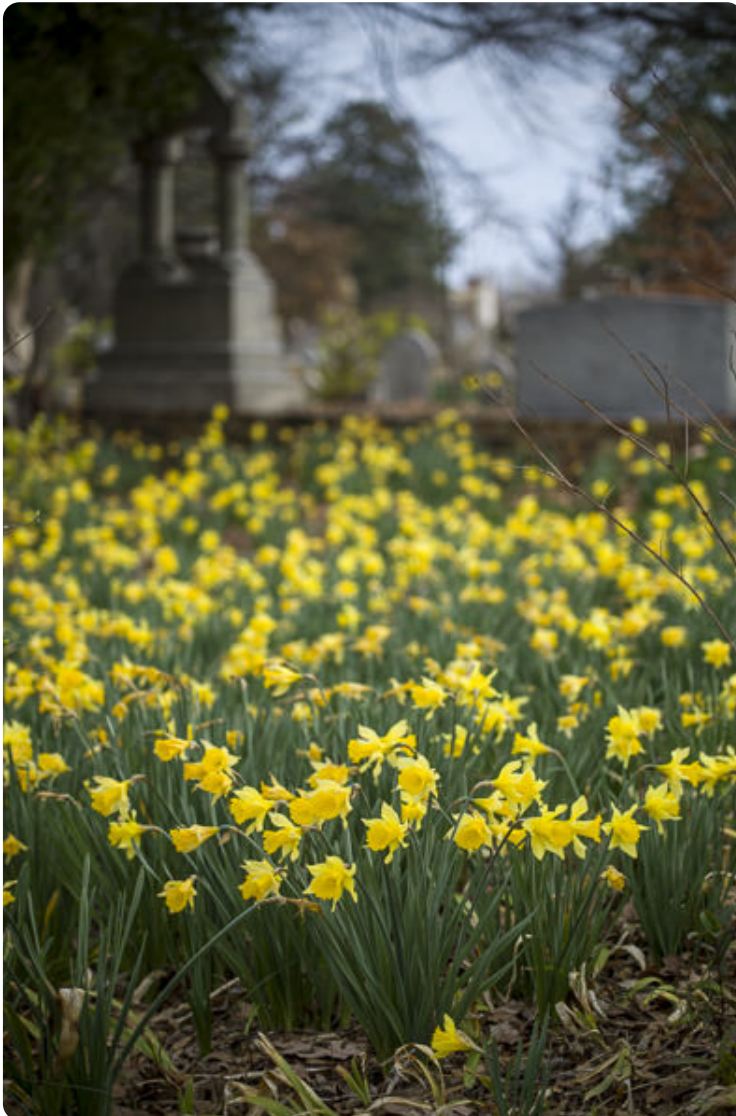

Being Hoosiers and Hollanders we were fortunate to receive some kind and expert help in selecting this sublist of trialed Southern performers. “Southern Zone limits” shown on the bulb’s Specifics table are USDA zones meant to be conservative (errors towards the cooler side). Asterisk indicate that there is no trial data for the cultivar, just a best guess (overheard rumor). Due to cooler nights and drier climates in the American Southwest you may consider those listed 8b to translate to your zone 10b.

## Historics

**O**ur nursery has many daffodils that have been continually dug and replanted since the 19th century. These older cultivars show a hybridiser's hand that is straightforward, friendly and elegant in style. We try to offer at least 50% historics.

## Pink Cups

Along with pink Cadillacs, pink grapefruit, and Pink Floyd, Pink-Cupped daffodils are a 20th century invention. Pink Cupped Narcissus are versatile, working

equally well in the border, in pot and for competition. Among the most charming of all.

Pink cups have the reputation to be more susceptible to water damage than the average daffodil. If this is true, giving them a home in a well drained place or in soil that is short on organic material and long on sand and gravel should help with their longevity. The pink color of the cup can be

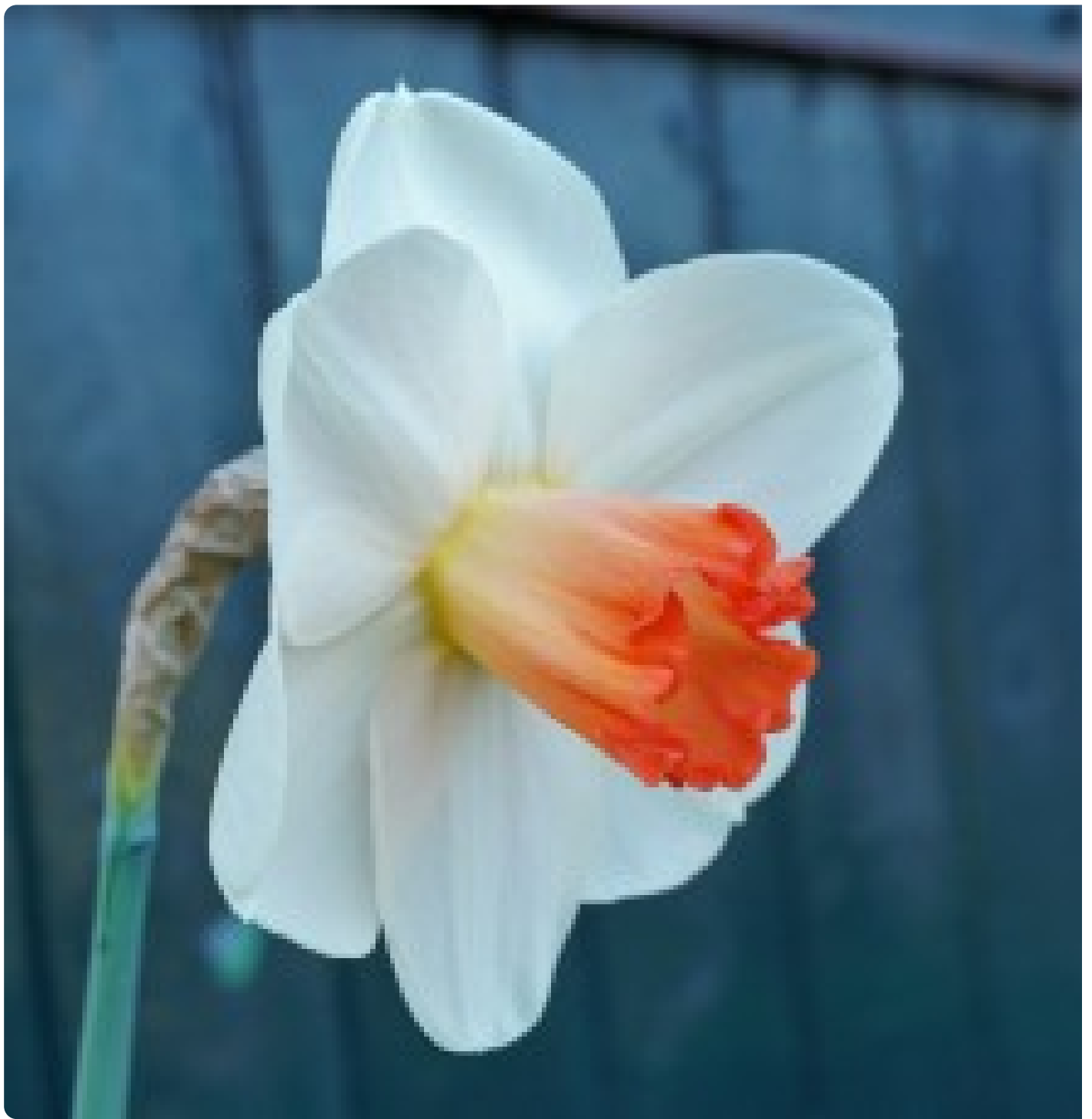

variable from place to place, from season to season. Anecdotally we are convinced that cool temperatures from when the bud of a pink cup breaks the ground until it opens helps develop an intense crustacean color. Afternoon shade may prove beneficial.

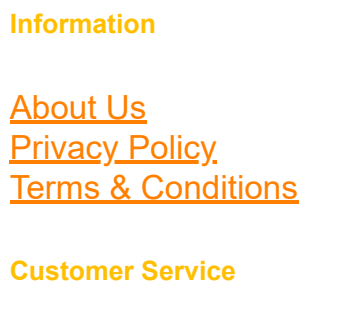

**B**ulbocodiums are winter bloomers that are almost always approved miniatures. Underused in the garden and rockery, they are ephemeral and long blooming, providing a continuum after the snowdrops, winter aconite and crocus have melted. If you are ga-ga for galanthus you will find charm in these narcissus.
