The Maryland Daffodil Society's decision to cancel their traditional daffodil show for the second year in a row was made with a heavy heart. On the bright side, it gave us a wonderful opportunity to explore other ways to serve our community and to keep our members connected. Ideas for community outreach began to bloom and a lineup of Covid-safe activities were put in motion.

From the get-go, the Board wanted to focus on thanking our crucial community service providers. We reached out to MDS members asking them to donate their daffodil blooms to honor our first responders, healthcare, and essential workers. Wow, did our members deliver! Over sixteen hundred blooms were collected and donated thanking our service workers at a local hospital, grocery store, and fire house for their support during the pandemic. MDS Immediate Past President, Hilles Whedbee, organized the collection and delivery of daffodil bouquets throughout the month of April to Healthcare workers. MDS member and Daffodil Judge Pat Parker honored essential workers at our local grocery store by giving away bouquets of daffodil blooms containing six different cultivars each. Catonsville Garden Club, an MDS Member, led by Joan Bender thanked local firefighters for their service with more bouquets of daffodils.

In addition to our "giving back" campaign, MDS members helped guide daffodil tours at Cylburn Arboretum, setup an educational daffodil display, record short daffodil education videos and submit daffodil photos to the MDS website for a virtual daffodil display. Members also organized and setup a once in a lifetime outdoor daffodil display of show quality blooms from the garden of longtime MDS member and Daffodil Judge Anne Donnell Smith.

It's easy to see that despite the pandemic, Maryland Daffodil Society members found many ways to share their joy of these special spring flowers and give back to the community at large.
