Set up will be on Friday at 1:00 p.m. and teardown on Sunday at 4:00 p.m. We need as many people as possible to help with both.


Anyone who can clerk, record, greet the public, or help in any other way is urgently needed. We will have a sign-up sheet available at the April  $6^{th}$  meeting.
