UK and EU orders NOT containing any of Brian Duncan's plants will be sent as soon as I can. UK orders including Brian's plants will be sent as soon as I can get the bulbs from him. Orders to outside the EU will all be sent together end of July/ August, as they will all need to be inspected together by FERA before dispatch. Snowdrops, cyclamen and Fritillaria davidii will be damp-packed for posting. All plants are flowering size, unless otherwise specified.





Anemone nemerosa Flash £15 4 available	A sport of 'Virescens' found in my garden. The usually plain green petaloids are splashed or wholly white, usually with deep blue bases. I would have said this was a cross between Virescens and Blue Eyes, but the former is completely sterile.	
Anemone nemerosa Maret £5 4 available	Lovely rounded semi-double.	
Anemone nemerosa Salt'n'Pepper £5 2 available	Odd anemone centred variety with brownish-olive ring of petaloids surrounding the white centre boss.	
Anemone ranunculoides Aive £20 2 available	Anemone-centred form, inner petals pointed, stamens and pistils in centre. Max one per customer.	
Anemone ranunculoides Anne £20 2 available	Anemone centred form, inner petals more rounded than in Aive.	
Anemone ranunculoides Ants £20 2 available	Similar to Anne, but centre greenish on opening.	
Anemone ranunculoides Aureus £20 3 available	Very full double, small green centre.	
Anemone ranunculoides Dagerort £20 3 available	Very full double form, many small rounded inner petals, surrounded by a ring of normal ones.	

Anemone ranunculoides Dago £20 1 available	Lovely anemone centred form, very regular.	
Anemone ranunculoides Ellen £20 3 available	Flower has a centre boss of spiky petaloids.	
Anemone ranunculoides Golden Dream £30 4 available	The most amazing of the Estonian yellows - flowers can vary from season to season, and within the same plant in one season. The flower usually has striking green petaloids emerging from the centre of the flower (as at top, right), but some flowers will be almost normal or with a condensed, dark green centre. Max one per customer.	
Anemone ranunculoides Hiiumaa £15 3 available	Anemone-centred double with spiky inner petals, and a ring of stamens between the inners and outers. One of the first to be discovered.	
Anemone ranunculoides Kadi £20 2 available	Very full double, greenish on opening.	
Anemone ranunculoides Kahar £10 3 available	Simple semi-double.	
Anemone ranunculoides Kreet £20 2 available	A pretty whirligig of spiky petaloids in the centre.	
Anemone ranunculoides Leena £20 1 available	Beautiful fully double form with a tiny green centre.	

Anemone ranunculoides Leida £20 3 available	Anemone-centred form, very regular.	
Anemone ranunculoides Linda £20 3 available	Very pretty anemone centred form with wide, overlapping outer petals and a full centre with green eye.	
Anemone ranunculoides Little Star £25 2 available	Curious full double with green streaks in the petals.	
Anemone ranunculoides Papa £20 3 available	Characterised by a deep warm gold colour. An anemone-centred form, full centre with pointed inners. Max two per customer.	
Anemone ranunculoides Saare £25 1 available	Full double with tiny red tips to the petals, and becoming bracteates with golden flashes in the bracts.	
Anemone ranunculoides Siil £20 4 available	Anemone centred form with a ring of stamens above the outermost petals.	
Anemone ranunculoides Sirje £20 2 available	Similar to Siil, but usually only one whorl of petaloids in the centre, and more whorls of stamens.	
Anemone ranunculoides Tafka £20 3 available	Very full regular double.	
Anemone ranunculoides Virve £20 3 available	An irregular anemone centred type with varying numbers of petaloids in the centre.	


Anemone x lipsiensis Schwefelfeuer £5 3 available	Hybrid of A. nemorosa and ranunculoides, with pale sulphur flowers. Selected form found in Antiesental, Austria.	
Anemone x lipsiensis Stiby £5 7 available	An unusual form found on Osterlen, in Sweden. A wonderful bracteate form of the hybrid between A. nemorosa and ranunculoides. Some of the delicate pale yellow petals flare out into leaf-like extensions.	
Corydalis Sixtus £4 10 available	Deep pink flowers on this C. solida variety.	
Crocus banaticus £4 10 available	Beautiful autumn-flowering crocus. Three long outer petals, three shorter upright inner ones and long lilac stigmata.	
Crocus banaticus darker flowers £5 6 available	Beautiful autumn-flowering crocus. Three long outer petals, three shorter upright inner ones and long lilac stigmata. This form selected has slightly darker flowers.	
Crocus banaticus First Snow £10 5 available	Pure white form of the species from Janis Ruksans.	
Crocus biflorus biflorus £2 10 available	Lovely spring crocus with buff coloured outer petals strongly feathered in deep maroon, over white inners.	
Crocus biflorus melantherus £4 10 available	An autumn flowering crocus. Flowers white with golden throat. Anthers black before dehiscence, stigma orange.	
Crocus hadriaticus £5 8 available	Very fine form of this autumn flowering crocus, thought to be var saundersianus. Very solid creamy white flowers with a yellow throat and purple tube.	



<p>Crocus Hubert Edelsten</p> <p>£3 7 available</p>	<p>Popular variety with white feathering on the deep violetouters that looks like light reflecting off them</p>	
<p>Crocus mathewii</p> <p>£10 15 available</p>	<p>Coveted autumn-flowering species, white petals with deep purple throat.</p>	
<p>Crocus tommasinianus Bobbo</p> <p>£3 11 available</p>	<p>An eyecatching form of this easy spring crocus with lavender flowers neatly tipped with white.</p>	
<p>Crocus tommasinianus Eric Smith</p> <p>£3 15 available</p>	<p>Pretty crocus with white flowers which usually have extra petals. Photo Mark Smyth.</p>	
<p>Crocus tommasinianus Pictus</p> <p>£3 7 available</p>	<p>Striking tommy with dark purple tips to the petals.</p>	
<p>Cyclamen coum albissimum</p> <p>£4 3 available</p>	<p>Flowering sized young tubers. White flowers without the pink 'nose'. 3 year-old tubers.</p>	
<p>Cyclamen coum dark flowers</p> <p>£4 4 available</p>	<p>Flowering sized tubers. Very dark crimson flowers and plain leaves.</p>	
<p>Cyclamen repandum album</p> <p>£5 12 available</p>	<p>Spring flowering species with ivy-shaped leaves, and sweetly scented white flowers. Flowering sized.</p>	
<p>Cyclamen rhodium peloponnesiacum</p> <p>£3 12 available</p>	<p>Spring flowering species with leaves freckled with silver, and sweetly scented pink flowers. 3 year-old tubers should be flowering sized.</p>	
<p>Fritillaria davidii</p> <p>£5 30 available</p>	<p>A very unusual Chinese fritillaria with yellow chubby bells chequered with brown on short stalks. The leaves are fascinating, ground hugging, leathery and with netted veins. Small bulbs offered, and I will put in some rice-grain bulblets for you to grow on as well.</p>	


<p>Galanthus Abingdon Green</p> <p>£8 11 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 25cm. Scapes almost upright, Flower length including ovary 40mm. Outer segments inrolled longitudinally. Leaves glaucous green, arching. Overall appearance is of a long narrow flower.</p>	
<p>Galanthus Anglesey Abbey</p> <p>£8 7 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 14cm. Scapes upright. Leaves glossy green, arching to upright. Noticeably green foliage is its main quality, but the dainty ovary, long claw and narrow flower segments make for delicate-looking flowers as well. Naturally small bulbs.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Armine'</p> <p>£10 13 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 16cm. Scapes upright, buds pointed. Flower length including ovary 42mm. Leaves at flowering time 14x110mm, glaucous, arching, plicate. Large flower, early.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Barnes'</p> <p>£8 16 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 18cm. Scapes upright. Flower length including ovary 30mm. Leaves glaucous, pleated. Neat narrow 'moustache' mark on inners. Very early flowering, sometimes in December.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Basisgrüner'</p> <p>£90 6 available</p>	<p>One Hagen Engelmann's green snowdrops. Green shaded lines across the outer segments and 2 pale 'eyes' at the base of the inner segments in addition to the bold green inverted U at the apex.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Bertram Anderson'</p> <p>£8 20 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 16cm. Scapes arching. Flower length including ovary 42mm. Leaves glaucous, arching. Huge flowers on short arching stems.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Bill Bishop'</p> <p>£8 20 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 12cm. Scapes arching. Flower length including ovary 48mm. Leaves glaucous, arching. Huge flowers on short arching stems. Outer petals longer than the similar Bertram Anderson.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Bitton'</p> <p>£4 2 available</p>	<p>Classic small snowdrop.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Blewbury Tart'</p> <p>£10 10 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 18cm. Scapes upright. Flower length 20mm, ovary much reduced. Outer segments are shaded green, or with some green lines on the distal 25%. Vigorous double 'spikey' snowdrop, flowers face outwards displaying dark green undersides of inner segments.</p>	



<p>Galanthus 'Blonde Inge'</p> <p>£10 8 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 10cm. Scapes arching, whole plant small and delicate. Flower length including ovary 25mm. Leaves at flowering time 7x100mm, glaucous, spreading. The first variety to have the combination of yellow mark and green ovary.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Cedric's Prolific'</p> <p>£6 15 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 21cm. Scapes upright. Flower length including ovary 38mm. Tall, vigorous snowdrop selected by Beth Chatto. Flowers have a two-tone X on inner segments.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Cicely Hall'</p> <p>£25 6 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 18cm. Scapes upright. Flower length including ovary 42mm. Distinctive dark spherical ovary. Waisted green mark extending almost full length of inners. Leaves bluish, upright. Tall sturdy plant, very upright.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Colossus'</p> <p>£8 25 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 23cm. Scapes angled, flower length including ovary 30mm. Leaves at flowering time 18x200mm, glaucous, glossy, arching. Tall robust snowdrop, increases well.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Compton Court'</p> <p>£5, or 5 for £20 40 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 19cm. Scapes upright, fat rounded buds. Flower length including ovary 40mm. Leaves glaucous, upright. Vigorous snowdrop with rounded flowers and short pedicel. Good garden variety which increases well. Flowers earlier than the similar S. Arnott.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Cordelia'</p> <p>£6 11 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 20cm. Scapes almost upright. Three outer segments, and regular inners heavily marked with green almost to the base. Good regular double snowdrop with very green-looking flowers.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Curly'</p> <p>£8 3 available</p>	<p>Delicate snowdrop famously very well scented. Green cross on inners fades to lime green towards the base. Sometimes shows green tips to the outers.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'David Shackleton'</p> <p>£8 3 available</p>	<p>Late flowering snowdrop with two-tone mark on inners and incurving outer segments.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Dionysus'</p> <p>£5 5 available</p>	<p>Greatorex double with green mark on outers smudged towards the base. Regular inner segments. Pedicel longer than spathe.</p>	




<p>Galanthus 'Dreycott Greentip'</p> <p>£10 9 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 8cm. Scapes upright. Inflated spathe (sometimes split). Leaves glaucous, arching. Green mark at end of outer segments, strength of mark varies in different years. Offered are bulbs that definitely had good green marks this year.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Elfin'</p> <p>£6 5 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 13cm. Scapes upright. Flower length including ovary 30mm. Leaves at flowering time 6x90mm, glaucous, spreading. Dwarf variety related to Scharlockii, showing green tips to the outers and split spathe.</p>	
<p>Galanthus elwesii dwarf form</p> <p>£10 5 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 10-15cm. Scapes almost upright. Flower length including ovary 35mm. Inner segments all green except for white edge and base. Leaves glaucous, arching. A dwarf form of elwesii from Mark Smyth.</p>	
<p>Galanthus elwesii monostictus</p> <p>£4 4 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 13cm. Scapes upright. Flower length including ovary 30mm. Leaves at flowering time 20x100mm, glaucous, arching. Inner marking usually 2 small dots.</p>	
<p>Galanthus elwesii monostictus col Leonid Bondarenko</p> <p>£25 2lg available</p>	<p>Sent to me from Estonia, this form was collected by the well-known Russian botanist.</p>	
<p>Galanthus elwesii monostictus Greentips</p> <p>£6 20 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 28cm. Scapes upright. Flower length including ovary 40mm. Leaves at flowering time 20x200mm, glaucous, upright, pleated. Distinctive large snowdrop with heavily textured outer petals with green marks at tips.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Ermine House'</p> <p>£15 3 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 24cm. Scapes upright, buds pointed. Leaves glaucous, upright. Neat, short, usually regular double, with a distinctive waisted mark on the inner segments.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Erway'</p> <p>£10 10 available</p>	<p>This snowdrop surprised me with its distinctiveness even at a distance. The flower stem is very upright with the flower hanging close to the stem, with an elongated olive green ovary as long as the inner segments which are almost all green.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Faith Stewart-Liberty'</p> <p>£30 8 available</p>	<p>Large-flowered snowdrop with distinctive inner mark and heavily textured outers.</p>	

<p>Galanthus 'Faringdon Double'</p> <p>£5 or £20 for 5 48 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 20cm. Scapes arching. Flower length including ovary 30mm, extra inner segments. Leaves glaucous, spreading. The earliest flowering double. Handsome flowers with normal number of outers which are distinctly ridged, and usually double the normal number of inner segments, making for a very neat flower.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Fieldgate Prelude'</p> <p>£10 12 available</p>	<p>One of Colin Mason's excellent finds, early flowering with distinctive two-tone cross on inner segments.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Fieldgate Superb'</p> <p>£20 5 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 21cm. Scapes very upright, flowers of heavy substance. Flower length including ovary 52mm. Inner segments have strong two-tone green X extending almost to the base. Leaves glaucous, upright, plicate. Very late snowdrop that has a great presence thanks to its huge flowers, vertical stance and strong inner mark.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Fly Fishing'</p> <p>£20 5 available</p>	<p>Tall snowdrop with large flowers on very long pedicels and good inverted heart on inner segments.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Forge Double'</p> <p>£15 10 available</p>	<p>Unusual very small double hybrid. Very late flowering, flowers are very narrow and pointed.</p>	<p>Sorry no photo</p>
<p>Galanthus fosteri</p> <p>£8 8 available</p>	<p>Beautiful species with flattened outer segments and inners with marks at base and apex. Leaves glossy dark green. Very strongly and sweetly scented. A favourite here.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Fred's Giant'</p> <p>£8 12 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 18cm. Scapes angled. Flower length including ovary 43mm.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Ginns Imperati'</p> <p>£10 12 available</p>	<p>A vigorous mid-season snowdrop famed for its powerful almond scent.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Godfrey Owen'</p> <p>£25 8 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 18cm. Justifiably popular, a very distinctive and beautiful flower, having 6 regular outer segments.</p>	




<p>Galanthus 'Greenish'</p> <p>£10 15 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 8cm. Scapes very upright. Flower length including ovary 22mm. Leaves spreading. A dainty small plant making very small bulbs.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Haconby Green'</p> <p>£45 1 available</p>	<p>A striking selection from Cliff Curtis, with solid green mark on inner segments and well-shaped large flowers. Rare.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Haydn'</p> <p>£6 13 available</p>	<p>Very early flowering, graceful snowdrop with long heart-shaped marking on inner segments.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Hill Poë'</p> <p>£7 8 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 17cm. Scapes upright, buds fat and pointed. Flower have 4 to 6 outers, very regular inners. Relatively large ovary for a double. Leaves glaucous, prostrate. Probably my favourite double, lampshade-like flowers held well clear of the short prostrate leaves.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Hippolyta'</p> <p>£5 14lg available</p>	<p>Flowering height 18cm. Scapes upright, globular buds. Flower length including ovary 30mm. Leaves glaucous, upright. Greatorex double.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Jacquenetta'</p> <p>£5 5 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 24cm. Scapes upright. Flower usually with green lines on distal 30% of outers, which are usually obvious on the fat, pointed buds. Leaves glaucous, arching. Vigorous, usually regular double.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Jessica'</p> <p>£10 9 available</p>	<p>A tall, vigorous elwesii with a bold X mark and green lines on the outer segments. The marks are variable, but these are very large bulbs that all were marked this spring.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'John Gray'</p> <p>£8 10 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 19cm. Scapes arching under the weight of the flower. Glossy bright green ovary. Flower length including ovary 45mm. Leaves glaucous, spreading. Large flowers, distinctive 2-tone bold X on inners.</p>	
<p>Galanthus Kite?</p> <p>£4 or £10 for 3 30 available</p>	<p>It appears that there is more than one clone going by this name, but this is how I obtained it. The flowers have a single heart-shaped mark on inner segments and occasionally produce 2 (this year even 3!) flowers on separate pedicels on the same scape. If it is not Kite then I'd be delighted if someone can tell me what it really is. Going cheap because of the uncertainty.</p>	


<p>Galanthus koenenianus x fosteri</p> <p>£35 2 available</p>	<p>Rare hybrid snowdrop, the leaves closely ridged on the backs. Dark inverted V at apex of inner segments, and pale green smudge at the base. Naturally small bulbs.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Lady Elphinstone'</p> <p>£12 10 available</p>	<p>At last I have some to offer of this stock of Lady Elph that consistently produces yellow marks. Every flower on this clump has been yellow for the past 5 years. These are maybe famous last words...</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Lambrook Greensleeves'</p> <p>£15 10 available</p>	<p>One from the famous ditch at East Lambrook Manor, distinctive bright green leaves, short stems.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Lambrook Tall'</p> <p>£25 1 available</p>	<p>Another from the famous ditch at East Lambrook Manor, this one tall with narrow leaves. Late flowering. Very Rare.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Lapwing'</p> <p>£10 10 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 20cm. Scapes upright. Mark on inners like a pair of scissors, handles dark green and blades lighter. Leaves glaucous, arching. Popular showy variety with distinctive markings.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Little Magnet'</p> <p>£4 4 available</p>	<p>Not really little! Beefy flowers on very long pedicels.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Lyn'</p> <p>£4 5 available</p>	<p>Small bulbs. An atkinsii type apt to throw abnormal flowers.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Mark's Tall'</p> <p>£15 12 available</p>	<p>Discovered by Mark Smyth, as found it was VERY tall – about 50cm high. The inner mark is a very fine perfect green inverted heart.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Merlin'</p> <p>£5 12 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 24cm. Scapes arching, distinctive spherical ovary. Leaves bluish, upright. Classic snowdrop with its signature spherical ovary and almost all deep green inner segments.</p>	


<p>Galanthus 'Mighty Atom'</p> <p>£6 or £15 for 3 15 available '</p>	<p>Scapes 18cm upright, but bent over under the weight of the flowers. Flower length including glossy, round ovary 45mm. Inner segments longitudinally ridged, the green mark fuzzy on the basal side. Leaves almost upright. Small plant – big flower!</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Modern Art'</p> <p>£12 12 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 19cm. Scapes upright. Flower length including ovary 35mm. Leaves glaucous, upright. Distinctive green mark at base and apex of outers. Another which can temporarily? lose its outer marks after chipping, offered are bulbs that have definitely had green marks this year.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Mrs McNamara'</p> <p>£7 or 3 for £18 40 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 26cm. Scapes upright. Very vigorous and early, as far as I know the only known tetraploid galanthus. Often the first to flower after the new year, well shaped solid flowers held above the spathe, and the flowers presented well above glaucous leaves.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Mrs Thompson'</p> <p>£10 9 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 16cm. Leaves glaucous, arching. Flowers often have extra outers, or 2 flowers per stem, sometimes fused together. A mad, fun snowdrop.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'North Star'</p> <p>£15 6 available</p>	<p>Discovered in John Sales' garden, an early double. Rare.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Ophelia'</p> <p>£5 3 available</p>	<p>Greatorex double. Flowering height 18cm. Leaves glaucous, arching.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Peardrop'</p> <p>£15 5 available</p>	<p>Discovered by Cliff Curtis in the Ketton garden, buds famously pear-drop shaped. Two tone green inner cross mark.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Peg Sharples'</p> <p>£12 10 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 14cm. Scapes arching. Flower length including ovary 35mm. Leaves at flowering time 12x100mm, glaucous, upright. Large flowers with long claw and bright green cross mark fading to base.</p>	
<p>Galanthus 'Primrose Warburg'</p> <p>£18 30 available</p>	<p>Flowering height 180mm. Scapes slightly arching. Leaves glaucous with a yellowish tinge, spreading. Flower has yellow ovary, longer spathe than Spindlestone Surprise, and the yellow mark on the inners has rounded ends to the 'arms' of the inverted U.</p>	




<p>Galanthus 'Ransome's Dwarf'</p> <p>£10 6 available</p>	<p>Dwarf snowdrop with large flowers and double mark on inner segments.</p>		<p>Galanthus 'Santa Claus'</p> <p>£15 2 available</p>	<p>Very early flowering snowdrop, usually in flower in December. A nice addition to Three Ships.</p>
