OFFERED HEREIN YOU WILL FIND A WONDERFUL SELECTION OF OUTSTANDING DAFFODILS, - MANY OF THE FINEST RECENT INTRODUCTIONS, AND THE BEST OF THE OLDER VARIETIES; ALSO A SELECT LIST OF DUTCH IRIS, HYACINTHS, TULIPS (AN 'OUT OF THIS WORLD' LISTING OF THESE), AND OTHER SPRING-FLOWERING BULBS. ALL ARE BEST QUALITY, TOP-SIZE BULBS, FROM MY FIELDS, OR FROM THOSE OF THE LEADING AND MOST RELIABLE GROWERS IN THE PACIFIC NORTH-WEST, GREAT BRITAIN, AND HOLLAND.

A LARGE NUMBER OF MESSRS. DUNLOP, RICHARDSON, AND WILSON'S ORIGINATIONS ARE OFFERED; ORDERS FOR MANY OF THEM, - ESPECIALLY THE NEWER, HIGHER PRICED ONES, - WILL BE FILLED WITH BULBS GROWN BY THESE GROWERS. OTHER VARIETIES OF THEIRS, NOT IN MY LIST, CAN BE SUPPLIED AT THEIR RETAIL PRICES, - WITH NO DISCOUNT; (VARIETIES WHICH ARE LISTED HEREIN ENJOY A VERY WORTHWHILE DISCOUNT, - IF YOUR ORDER IS SENT IN, THIS SPRING.) PLEASE KEEP THIS DISCOUNT IN MIND WHEN COMPARING PRICES, - AT LEAST 20%, AND PROBABLY MORE, ON A GOOD SIZED ORDER; MORE ON THIS IN A FOLLOWING PARAGRAPH, UNDER 'TERMS, ETC.', AND ON THE ORDER-SHEET. (IF YOU PREFER, YOU MAY HAVE THESE IRISH GROWER'S VARIETIES WHICH I DO LIST, AT THEIR RETAIL PRICES, WITH NO DISCOUNT.)

I PRESUME THAT MANY OF YOU TO WHOM THIS LIST IS BEING SENT ARE PRIMARILY INTERESTED IN DAFFODILS, AND BUILDING UP A COLLECTION OF THEM; BUT IF YOU ARE ALSO INTERESTED IN MAKING YOUR GARDEN AND HOME GROUNDS AS ATTRACTIVE AND COLORFUL AS POSSIBLE, - AND THAT OVER THE LONGEST POSSIBLE TIME THRU THE SPRING, - YOU CANNOT DO WITHOUT A GENEROUS PLANTING OF TULIPS, HYACINTHS, ETC. THESE OTHER BULBS DO NOT COMPETE WITH THE DAFFODILS, BUT RATHER, SUPPLEMENT THEM, AND ADD TO THEIR BEAUTY. THE CROCUSES, IN VARYING SHADES OF BLUE AND PURPLE, IN YELLOW OR WHITE, WILL FURNISH BRIGHT PATCHES OF COLOR, BEFORE THE EARLIEST DAFFODILS. THE HYACINTHS, IN MANY SHADES OF PINK, RED, BLUE, PURPLE, PALE YELLOW AND PUREST WHITE, AND THE EARLIER TULIPS (FOSTERIANA, SINGLE EARLY, DOUBLE EARLY) COME INTO BLOOM, IN THEIR GAY COLORS, ALONG WITH MANY OF THE DAFFODILS. THESE CONTRASTING COLORS ARE VERY EFFECTIVE IN BORDERS, AMONGST SHRUBBERY, ETC. THE HYBRID DARWINS TOO, BLOOM WITH THE LATER DAFFODILS, AND A PLANTING OF THESE IMMENSE FLOWERS, IN THEIR GORGEOUS REDS, CRIMSON, SCARLET, ETC., BEHIND DUKE OF WINDSOR, ILE DE FRANCE, KILWORTH, WHITE LION, OR OTHER DAFFODILS, IS A BREATH-TAKING SIGHT. THEN WHEN THE DAFFODIL SEASON IS NEARLY OVER, AND WE ARE LAMENTING THIS FACT, THE REST OF THE DARWINS, THE BREEDERS, COTTAGE, AND PARROT TULIPS BURST UPON THE LANDSCAPE, IN ALL THE COLORS OF THE RAINBOW, AND (PRACTICALLY) BRING TO AN END THE SPRING BULB SEASON, IN A BLAZE OF GLORY. THAT IS, EXCEPT FOR THE DUTCH IRIS, WHICH USUALLY COME A WEEK OR TWO AFTER THE LAST OF THE TULIPS; THEIR BRIGHT COLORS, - BLUES, LAVENDER, YELLOW, CREAM, WHITE, - ARE VERY ATTRACTIVE IN THE GARDEN; THEY ARE ALSO ESPECIALLY DESIRABLE FOR CUTTING.

MOST OF THESE BULBS, - ESPECIALLY THE HYACINTHS, AND THE EARLIER TULIPS, AS WELL AS MANY DAFFODILS, - ARE ALSO SPLENDID FOR GROWING INDOORS, IN POTS. IF POTTED UP IN GOOD TIME, THEY MAY BE HAD IN BLOOM BY MID-JANUARY, OR A LITTLE LATER, TO BRIGHTEN AND CHEER YOUR HOME, AND TO BRING A TOUCH OF SPRING-TIME, LONG BEFORE IT ARRIVES OUTDOORS. POTS MAY BE SECURED FROM YOUR LOCAL FLORIST, ALONG WITH INFORMATION ON THE PROCEDURE TO FOLLOW. INFORMATIVE ARTICLES ON THIS PHASE OF BULB GROWING WILL ALSO BE FOUND IN MANY GARDEN MAGAZINES AND PUBLICATIONS. SO, WHY NOT INCLUDE AT LEAST A FEW BULBS FOR THIS PURPOSE, AND A NICE LOT OF THESE OTHER BULBS FOR OUTDOOR PLANTING, ALONG WITH YOUR DAFFODIL ORDER, AND HAVE THEM IN BLOOM OVER A PERIOD OF NEARLY FOUR MONTHS.

TERMS, CONDITIONS OF SALE, ETC.
(PLEASE READ CAREFULLY)

EARLY ORDERING: PLEASE, PLACE YOUR ORDER THIS SPRING, -NOT LATER THAN MAY 15TH.; STOCKS OF MANY VARIETIES OFFERED ARE LIMITED, BUT BULBS OF THESE VARIETIES, IF I DO NOT HAVE ENOUGH, CAN BE ORDERED FROM THE PREVIOUSLY MENTIONED GROWERS, IF YOUR ORDER IS RECEIVED IN TIME. ALSO, ALL OF THE TULIPS, HYACINTHS, ETC. MUST BE IMPORTED, AND SO THAT I MAY KNOW WHAT I WILL NEED, IN GOOD TIME, IT IS NECESSARY THAT YOUR ORDER REACH ME BY MAY 15TH. (MINIMUM AMOUNT OF ORDER - 3.50, PLEASE).

ALL ORDERS RECEIVED BY THIS DATE WILL BE ENTITLED TO A GENEROUS DISCOUNT, IN CASH OR EXTRA BULBS (VARIETIES OF YOUR CHOICE). THE SIZE OF THIS DISCOUNT DEPENDS ON THE SIZE OF YOUR ORDER; THESE FIGURES ARE GIVEN ON THE ORDER-SHEET, WHICH IS ENCLOSED, - UNLESS YOU HAVE GOTTEN THIS LIST THRU A GARDEN CLUB WHICH IS GETTING UP AN ORDER, IN WHICH CASE THE DISCOUNT GOES TO THE CLUB, FOR SOME WORTH-WHILE PROJECT.

PRICES: THE PRICES QUOTED ARE FOR HIGHEST QUALITY BULBS, -THE DAFFODILS D.N.#1, OR LARGER, (EXCEPT FOR SOME WHICH DO NOT MAKE LARGE BULBS), AND THE OTHERS, TOP-SIZE. THE DAFFODILS ARE PRICED PER BULB, WITH 12 FOR THE PRICE OF 10, AND 6 OR 3 AT THE SAME RATE (6 FOR THE PRICE OF 5, AND 3 FOR 2½ TIMES THE SINGLE BULB PRICE). 100 MAY BE HAD FOR 70 TIMES THE EACH PRICE, - OR 7 TIMES THE DOZ. PRICE. THE TULIPS, HYACINTHS, ETC. ARE PRICED PER DOZEN (NO LESS THAN 6 OF A VARIETY SOLD), AND LIKEWISE, 100 BULBS ARE 7 TIMES THE DOZEN PRICE. AS THIS 100 RATE IS A 30% DISCOUNT FROM THE SINGLE BULB PRICE, NO FURTHER DISCOUNT IS ALLOWED WHERE IT IS USED.

PAYMENT IN FULL (CHECK OR MONEY-ORDER) SHOULD BE MADE WITH YOUR ORDER (EXCEPTING GARDEN CLUBS), IF YOU WISH TO TAKE ADVANTAGE OF THE DISCOUNT. OTHERWISE, 25% WITH THE ORDER, AND THE BALANCE SEPTEMBER 1ST., - OR C. O. D., IF YOU PREFER.

PLEASE ADD A SUFFICIENT AMOUNT FOR POSTAGE, ACCORDING TO THE FOLLOWING TABLE, TO THE TOTAL OF YOUR ORDER, -UNLESS YOU WISH IT SENT BY EXPRESS. (P. POST USUALLY COSTS LESS, EXCEPT FOR SHIPMENTS OF 40-50 LB. OR MORE, GOING LONG DISTANCES). IF TOO MUCH IS SENT, -AN APPRECIABLE AMOUNT, -EXTRA BULBS WILL BE SENT FOR SAME.

IF BEYOND THE 6TH. ZONE, PLEASE INQUIRE AT YOUR P.O. AS TO THE CORRECT AMOUNT, ALLOWING 3 LB. TO THE DOZEN FOR DAFFODILS AND HYACINTHS, 1 LB. PER DOZ. FOR TULIPS, AND ½ LB. FOR THE SMALLER BULBS.

*(THESE FIGURES ARE FOR DAFFODILS AND HYACINTHS; FOR TULIPS AND THE OTHER SMALLER BULBS, ALLOW 1/3 WHAT THE SAME NO. OF DAFFODILS WOULD TAKE, -MINIMUM .35, IF ORDER IS FOR THESE BULBS ONLY.)

MOST GARDEN CLUB ORDERS ARE SENT BY RAILWAY EXPRESS, OR MOTOR FREIGHT, AND THESE CHARGES ARE PAID ON RECEIPT OF THE BULBS.

DELIVERY WILL BE MADE AT PLANTING TIME, AS EARLY IN SEPTEMBER AS POSSIBLE FOR NORTHERN ORDERS, AND OCTOBER IN THE SOUTH; IT MAY BE MID-OCTOBER, OR A LITTLE LATER BEFORE ALL THESE LATTER ORDERS ARE OUT, BUT THEY WILL STILL BE IN PLENTY OF TIME TO MAKE GOOD ROOT GROWTH BEFORE WINTER, IF PLANTED SHORTLY AFTER THEIR ARRIVAL.

GUARANTEE: I EXERCISE EVERY CARE AND PRECAUTION IN KEEPING STOCKS TRUE TO NAME, AND BUY BULBS ONLY FROM OTHER GROWERS WHO DO THE SAME. HOWEVER, 'MIX-UPS' CAN OCCUR, AND SHOULD THIS HAPPEN, AND ANY VARIETY PROVE UNTRUE, SAME WILL BE REPLACED. (BUT, PLEASE REMEMBER THAT UNSEASONABLE WEATHER, -ESPECIALLY HOT AND DRY, -AFFECTS THE COLORING, SUBSTANCE, AND EVEN THE FORM OF MANY VARIETIES, SO THAT THEY ARE HARDLY RECOGNIZABLE AS THE SAME VARIETY.) LIKEWISE, TO THE BEST OF MY KNOWLEDGE, ONLY SOUND, HEALTHY BULBS ARE SENT OUT; MY FIELDS AND HARVESTED BULBS, AND THOSE OF THE GROWERS FROM WHOM I BUY, ARE REGULARLY INSPECTED BY THE PROPER AUTHORITIES. ANY BULBS FAILING TO COME UP AND GROW SATISFACTORILY THE FIRST SEASON WILL BE REPLACED, BUT I CANNOT ACCEPT RESPONSIBILITY FOR THEIR BEHAVIOUR AFTER THAT, AS THIS IS DETERMINED BY CIRCUMSTANCES AND CONDITIONS OVER WHICH I HAVE NO CONTROL.

ALSO, I VERY SELDOM SUBSTITUTE WITHOUT PERMISSION, AND THIS USUALLY ONLY LATE IN THE SEASON, - ON ORDERS (FOR OLDER VARIETIES) WHERE I AM ALMOST CERTAIN THAT IT WILL NOT BE OBJECTED TO, -WITH BETTER, AND OFTEN HIGHER PRICED VARIETIES.

"BLUE RIBBON WINNERS": IN THE INTERESTS OF SAVING SPACE, AND CUTTING COSTS THIS SECTION HAS BEEN OMITTED, BUT YOU WILL FIND MOST OF THESE VARIETIES, DESIGNATED AS SHOW FLOWERS BY THE LETTER 'S' PRECEDING THE NAME, IN THE LIST OF CHOICE DAFFODILS, BEGINNING ON THE NEXT PAGE. IF YOU WOULD LIKE THESE NAMES, AS GIVEN IN MY 1959 LIST, I WILL BE GLAD TO SEND SAME TO YOU, ON REQUEST; ALSO THE CULTURAL NOTES IF DESIRED, WHICH TOO HAVE CURRENTLY BEEN LEFT OUT.

GIFT ORDERS: IF YOU WOULD LIKE TO GIVE SOME BULBS TO A RELATIVE OR FRIEND, AS A BIRTHDAY GIFT, OR FOR SOME OTHER OCCASION, JUST SEND ME THE AMOUNT WHICH YOU WISH TO SPEND (MINIMUM 3.50), AND I WILL SEND GIFT CERTIFICATE, AND MY LIST TO THE PERSON TO BE REMEMBERED, - SO THAT THEY MAY SELECT THE VARIETIES DESIRED, (UNLESS YOU WISH TO DO THIS YOURSELF).

IT IS LOVELY HERE IN OUR VALLEY BETWEEN THE MOUNTAINS IN THE SPRING, - OR ANY OTHER TIME; YOU WILL LIKE THE ATTRACTIVE HOTEL HEADQUARTERS, AND THE ACCOMMODATIONS THERE, - BETTER THAN MOST AT PREVIOUS CONVENTIONS, AND AT VERY REASONABLE RATES. THERE WILL BE THE USUAL ADDRESSES (MAYBE NOT QUITE SO MANY AS USUAL), CONFERENCES, DINNERS, AND THE BANQUET, AS WELL AS VISITS TO A NUMBER OF OUTSTANDING GARDENS. THOSE OF MRS. J. CHOICE DAFFODILS

LIMITED SPACE ALLOWS ONLY THE BRIEFEST OF DESCRIPTIONS, WHICH ARE VERY INADEQUATE, AND WHICH MAKE LARGE NUMBERS OF VARIETIES APPEAR TO BE VERY SIMILAR. HOWEVER, IF YOU HAVE SEEN THESE VARIETIES AT SHOWS, OR IN YOUR FRIEND'S (OR OTHER'S) GARDENS, YOU CAN SEE THAT MOST ARE QUITE DISTINCT, WITH CHARACTERISTICS OF THEIR OWN.

IF YOU HAVE ATTENDED SOME OF THE SHOWS AND/OR VISITED GARDENS WHERE THEY ARE FEATURED, YOU LIKELY HAVE MADE LISTS OF THE VARIETIES WHICH YOU WOULD LIKE TO HAVE IN YOUR GARDEN NEXT SPRING. IF YOU HAVE NOT BEEN ABLE TO DO THIS, THERE IS INFORMATION ENOUGH GIVEN HERE TO ENABLE YOU TO SELECT THE PROPER VARIETIES FOR YOUR NEEDS, -

THE NUMBER AND LETTER PRECEDING THE NAME DENOTES THE CLASS (OR DIVISION) TO WHICH THE VARIETY BELONGS, - SEE R.H.S. CLASSIFICATION ON PAGE 23 (INSIDE BACK COVER).

VARIETIES MARKED WITH AN ASTERISK (*) ARE ESPECIALLY RECOMMENDED FOR CUTTING, AND LANDSCAPE USE. THEY ARE STRONG GROWING, FREE FLOWERING, AND PRICED SO THAT THEY MAY BE USED IN QUANTITY; (100 MAY BE HAD FOR 70 TIMES THE SINGLE BULB PRICE). AN 'S' BEFORE THE NAME DENOTES THAT IT IS A SHOW FLOWER, A VARIETY WHICH IF WELL GROWN, AND GIVEN A LITTLE SPECIAL CARE AND PROTECTION, SHOULD WIN BLUE RIBBONS FOR YOU AT YOUR DAFFODIL AND OR SPRING FLOWER SHOWS. (MANY OTHER VARIETIES, NOT SO MARKED, ARE ALSO OFTEN 'WINNERS'.)

THE NAMES IN PARENTHESES FOLLOWING THE VARIETY NAMES, ARE THOSE OF THE ORIGINATORS OF THOSE VARIETIES; THE LETTERS FOLLOWING THESE GIVE THE APPROXIMATE RELATIVE BLOOMING SEASON: EE, EXTRA EARLY; E, EARLY; EM, EARLY MID-SEASON; M, MID-SEASON; LM, LATE MID-SEASON; L, LATE; LL, VERY LATE.
