for GREAT BRITAIN only:

All orders are shipped together from Holland to a British harbour and from there forwarded by post or delivery service to your address. This will shorten the time that the bulbs are on the way and reduce the costs of carriage, packing, etc.. In this way it is possible to settle all these costs, included V.A.T. at 25% of the value of the bulbs with a minimum of £ 2.00 for each order.
