


1991 DAFFODIL INTRODUCTIONS

BRYCE CANYON, 3 (DuBose) 2W-P A4-4 (Accent x Salmon Trout) A row of these in the field is almost military in their precision. Sturdy stems hold the 90 degree facing, medium sized flowers at a uniform 14 inches. The wide, crisp white petals are dress parade smooth. The slightly flared mid-length cups are reminiscent of the tawny rose and salmon sandstone of Utah's Bryce Canyon. A touch of ruffling on the cup edges releases any notion of over discipline. At ease on the show bench or in the garden...22044.....35.00


CRYSTAL CHALICE, 4 (DuBose) 2W-WWY A28-20 (Pretender x Salmon Trout) A rounded flower of crystalline white with broad smooth segments. Gently flared 1 inch cups open a soft yellow which quickly fades, leaving only a sharp yellow edge with moderate ruffling. Vigorous plant with good stem and neck, ADS Rose Ribbon winner...22415.....25.00

GEOMETRICS, 3 (DuBose) 2W-Y MS42-30 (Precedent x Camelot) Among some yearling bulbs given Sid DuBose by Mary Dunn of Sacramento CA to grow was this lovely flower. So precisely made, it could be a skilled draftsman's rendition of the ideal show daffodil. Wide immaculately smooth perianth segments of white are finely drawn and have a thick waxy substance. They meet the goblet shaped, half length, soft yellow, minutely rolled cup in perfect symmetry. Large flowers are poised on strong sturdy stems. Cup pigmentation seems to deepen after picking, so take this one early for maximum color contrast. ADS Mitsch Trophy and Rose Ribbon winner San Francisco '89...22106.....50.00



GILT COMPLEX, 4 (DuBose) 2Y-Y A14-1 (Aircastle x Salmon Trout) Two equilateral triangles of wide immaculately smooth petals are superimposed on one another. Opening color is palest lemon cream which slowly undergoes a complex series of changes to end as a glittering gilt. The gray green eyed, semi-flaring cup is banded by a lightly ruffled border of deep gold. Though attractive in any of its color changes we feel it should be shown after reaching maximum pigmentation, hence the 2y-y. On the West Coast, Gilt Complex revels in the hot dry sunny seasons. Well poised on 16" stems, producing a high percentage of show flowers. A personal favorite of Sid DuBose...22436.....35.00


NOB HILL, 3 (DuBose) 2YW-Y G26-15 (Daydream x Sabine Hay) Flat, utterly smooth rounded petals of a sharp and shimmering yellow have a white halo at their base. The blocky one and one half inch cups are slightly flared and edged with tiny ruffles. Good stems with upward facing flowers, extremely consistent for the show bench. Can be a reverse near death but at its prime is a 2yw-y. Best in the hybridizers section San Francisco '89...22414.....45.00



RANDOM EVENT, 4 (DuBose) 3W-YOY D55A5 (Glenwherry op) Resembles the Glenwherry sibling, Pride of Erin. This tall graceful flower sports a smooth flat perianth of dazzling poeticus white. Modest petal width compliments the slightly flared yellow rim on the orange cup. Most blooms are show flowers. Pick this one early to preserve its brilliant color. ADS White and Rose Ribbon winner, Walnut Creek, California 1988...23168.....25.00

TAMALE PIE, 2 (Hager) 2Y-O D47 (Cinel x (Ambergate x Velvet Robe)) The tall showy flowers on strong stems bloom early but are long lasting. The petals are a deep golden yellow and round. The large, flaring, and ruffled cup is a vermilion orange. Wonderful garden flower and an occasional show daffodil...22347.....25.00





BRIGHT SPANGLES, 2 (DuBose) 8Y-O C34-6 (Matador OP) A welcome new addition to the poetaz. Large relatively smooth florets of tawny gold are highlighted by dark orange cups. Most scapes will have 4-6 flowers. Hardy in mid-Ohio and possibly farther north ... 28006..... 25.00



DOVE SONG, 4 (DuBose) 2W-WWP C43-8 (Rainbow x Carita) Wide, satin smooth petals of sparkling white reflex gently, flared modest cups of white, broadly banded with rose-salmon ruffles ... 22438 25.00

HALFTONE, 4 (DuBose) 3W-Y E71-1 (Olivet selfed) A precisely formed flower of medium size. Circular petals of clean white form a smooth orbicular background for the small flat cup and dainty yellow rim. Brian Duncan commented about its excellent form when here in '91 ... 23179 25.00


MISTRESS MINE, 3 (DuBose) 2WG-P E32-2 (Celilo x Cool Flame) Voluptuous cups of true medium pink tapered and ruffled arise from the green bases of the wide immaculately flat white perianth. A refined ruffling adds charm. Well posed flowers on mid-length stems are remarkably consistent. Winner of the ADS Rose ribbon and best pink in Walnut Creek Show, Ca. 1991 ... 22437..... 40.00



RASPBERRY ROSE, 3 (DuBose) 2W-P H76-24 (Kens Favorite x Verran) Aptly named, the deep coloration is a delight to the eye. Mid-length cups are slightly tapered and their modest flare is neatly serrated. Pristine white major petals almost overlap, inner petals are slightly narrower, giving a nicely rounded flower. In winning American Bred Class

by Bob Spotts, Descanso Gardens, CA, 1991. Color is most intense in cool, wet weather. Well liked by David Jackson during his visit here in 1988 ... 22104..... 40.00







'Jubilant Spirit' 4 (DuBose) 2W-P M73-3 [D53-6 (Precedent x Cordial) x Dailmanach] - An intense pink of good form and substance. The back petals are very wide and rounded. The cup is slightly flaired and serrated. It has an excellent pose and should be a bright spot in the garden and on the show bench. ... 22445 35.00

'Pale Hands' 4 (DuBose) 2W-PL56-4 [Salome x E80-3 (Peace Pipe x N58-2 (Rima x Alpine Glow))] A pale pink flower of precise form. Its heritage certainly shows. The perianth is very flat and smooth, but slightly pointed. It forms two perfect triangles. The cup is rather straight with a slight flair. It has a little green at the base and is pale pink to the rim which is more apricot pink. An excellent flower in every way. ... 22449 35.00

'Remembered Kiss' 4 (DuBose) 2W-WWP I58-13 [Dove Song x D27-1 (Flamingo x Salome)] - An excellent rimmed pink, even more intense in color than its parent Dove Song. Nicely rounded petals, but not ultra wide. Very white perianth provides great contrast to the deep pink rim of the cup. The perianth is very flat. Good grower. ... 22446 25.00

'Soothing Touch' 3 (DuBose) 2Y-WWY K47-1 [B64-2 (Rima x Moonshot) x D12-10 (Camelot x Daydream)] A nice, creamy lemon yellow perianth is wide, flat and round. The cup is paler with a deeper yellow rim. It is flaired and serrated at the rim, almost a roll. The flower has excellent substance and is long lasting in the garden. ... 22447 25.00

'Star Shine' 4 (DuBose) 2W-P J10-3 (Easter Moon x Arctic Char) This excellent flower could easily be called a pink Starmount. It was called 'Cast Iron' in the seedling field for the heavy substance and lasting qualities. The perianth is slightly reflexed which adds to its charm. The straight sided cup is deeply colored pink with a deeper pink rim. Should do well in the garden and on the show bench. ... 22448 35.00
