solitary yellow flowers, March, 3"	
<i>Narcissus bulbicodium obesus</i>	\$.25
large yellow flowers on short stems, leaves prostrate, 4-5"	
<i>Narcissus bulbicodium romieuxii</i>	\$.25
pale creamy yellow flowers, needs protection but will bloom outside in zone 5, 6-8"	
<i>Narcissus bulbicodium tenuifolius</i>	\$.25
yellow, free flowering miniature, needs protection, may be best in pots, 5"	
<i>Narcissus canaliculatus</i>	\$.25
white perianth, bright golden cup, April, 6-8"	
<i>Narcissus cyclamineus</i>	\$.35
small, clear yellow flowers, perianth much reflexed, March-April, 4-6"	
<i>Narcissus cyclamineus Beryl</i>	\$.35
primrose yellow with small globular orange cup, reflexed perianth, 8"	
<i>Narcissus cyclamineus Jenny</i>	\$.65
pure white reflexed perianth, slender pale primrose crown, stiff wiry stems, F.C.C. Wisley, 1974, April, 12"	
<i>Narcissus gracilis</i>	\$.70
light sulphur yellow, flat cup, 3-5 flowers per stem sweet scented, May, 10-12"	
<i>Narcissus jonquilla</i>	\$.25
golden yellow, multiple blooms per stem, scented, 12"	
<i>Narcissus juncifolius</i>	\$.25
deep yellow, 1-5 flowers in an umbel, scented, April, 4-6"	
<i>Narcissus lobularis</i>	\$.25
lemon yellow perianth, broad yellow trumpet, March, 8"	
<i>Narcissus rupicola</i>	\$.30
deep yellow solitary flowers, shallow six lobed cup, April, 6-8"	
<i>Narcissus scaberulus</i>	\$.30
orange yellow, 1-2 flowers per stem, small wrinkled corona March-April, 6"	
<i>Narcissus triandrus albus</i>	\$.30
Angels Tears, several creamy white flowers per stem, perianth reflexed, 4-10"	
<i>Narcissus triandrus Hawera</i>	\$.50
clear lemon yellow, 4-6 pendulous flowers per stem, perianth reflexed, several stems per bulb, 8"	
<i>Narcissus W.P. Milner</i>	\$.50
creamy white, miniature trumpet daffodil, fine for rock garden or pots, 8"	
<i>Ornithogalum balansae</i>	\$.30
large umbel of white flowers, striped green on reverse, March-April, 4-6"	
<i>Oxalis adenophylla</i>	\$.45
Valdivian Alps, Chile, to 9000', light lilac pink, gray foliage, sun, good drainage, 3"	
<i>Oxalis lobata</i>	\$ 1.45
South America to 6000', golden yellow, Sept.-Oct., may produce leaves in spring, not quite hardy, needs good winter protection or pots, 3"	
<i>Scilla amethystina</i> (<i>S. pratensis</i>)	\$.45
brilliant blue flowers in a dense raceme, Yugoslavia to 6000', sunny, well drained spot, 3-10"	
<i>Scilla bifolia</i>	\$.20
deep gentian blue, March, 4-6"
