

ARELEY KINGS 4 (Lea, UK) 2WW Misty Glen x Croila

Pure white from the famous JSB Lea. Used in his winning Engleheart collections, large and much like its pollen parent. First time listing in NZ.

BERCEUSE 5 (Mitch, USA) 2WP Pink Frost x (Rose Caprice x Accent)

One of the best pinks we grow, late flowering so seldom seen at shows - a challenge for pot growers. Broad white perianth and funnel-shaped cup of pure pink touched with shades of lavender.

CAMEO BARON 3-4 (93:60 Ramsay, NZ) (O'M49/64 Narvik x Red Baron) x Torridon 2YR

A continuation of Jim O'More's Ivo Fell crosses - Red Baron was a key to Jim's efforts to improve colour. Combined with Torridon, we have achieved an intense red, frilly corona and a deep yellow rounded perianth of great substance. In our winning classes South Island National 1998, photograph p.148 ADS Journal, March 1999. A real winner.

CAMEO REBEL 4 (92:113 Ramsay, NZ) Red Era x (A.Chappell Sdg Checkmate x *Cressella*) 3Y - YRR

Bred from pollen given to us by the late Alf Chappell - hence the name! Just what you look for in late red yellows, exceptionally broad, round perianth, spreading bowl cup with strong red band. Much sought after, see photograph p.149 ADS Journal, March 1999.

CRYSTAL STAR 3 (Mitsch, USA) 2YY Camelot x Aurum

The best 2YY to come out of the States and amongst the best we grow here. A very strong grower, triangular petals slightly rounded. Best 2YY Nelson National 1997. Smooth flower which stands out on long stems. Recommended

DESERT STORM 2 (Postles, UK) 2YR Torridon x Loch Hope

Just what you'd expect from this breeding - a smooth, medium sized, strongly coloured flower with deep substance. Excellent show record including Best Bloom at Solihull in 1996. A real jewel and great constitution. Also a must for breeders.

GULL 3 (Mitsch, USA) 2WW Easter Moon x Broughshane Sdg.

A pure white flower which grows well here - many best bloom awards to its credit in USA. Good substance and mid-white petals, slightly pointed with round, funnel-shaped frilled cup. Worthwhile.

HEAMOOR 1 (Scamp, UK) 4YY St Keverne x Tamar Fire

The first we've listed from Ronny Scamp of Cornwall. A vigorous double which opens without any problems, premier at Morrinsville 1997, included in winning double collections at National level. Medium sized and very even, shows a little red here. Different and a good addition for serious breeders of doubles!

NONCHALANT 5 (Jackson, AUS) 3Y - GYY Lemonade x Seedling

But for its lateness, this would be listed at treble the price! Best described as a yellow Sea Dream, round flower, solid yellow with small crimped cup. A genuine small cup. Excellent substance. A must for breeders.

POLAR MORN 3 (Hunter, NZ) 3WW Polar Imp x Polar Dawn

Several premiers to its credit in New Zealand, a very round well formed small cup in a weak division. Very consistent and proven by many growers to be amongst the best. Should be in every collection.

POL CROCAN 4 (Lea, UK) 2WP Seedling x Seedling

John's best pink outside of Dailmanach. Pure white, glossy round petals complement a cherry pink round, fluted cup of intense colour. Strong grower, one to look forward to in late season.
