<i>N. cantabricus</i> A winter bloomer with beautiful white flowers for an alpine house or mild climate.	\$3.00	___
<i>N. fernandesii</i> A dainty species with two to four golden flowers on a 6 - 8 in. stem. The foliage is dark green and round.	\$3.00	___
<i>N. intermedius</i> A wild hybrid (jonquilla x tazetta) that is slightly tender. It is rare and has possibilities for use in breeding. Yellow perianth and orange corona. Half-hardy.	\$5.00	___
<i>Pseudo-narcissus moschatus</i> A charming white, drooping, old fashioned trumpet.	\$3.00	___
<i>Pseudo-narcissus obvallaris</i> Called the Tenby Daffodil, a medium sized, yellow flower of a hardy nature.	\$1.00	___
<i>N. odorus</i> "Rugulosus" A delightful yellow flower with a scalloped corona. It is 12 - 12 in. tall with one to four florets. Scented.	\$1.00	___

Little Beauty A small, bi-colored trumpet. Early.	\$1.50	___
Little Gem A favorite, yellow, well proportioned trumpet. Good for the rock garden.	\$2.50	___
Minnow A tazetta hybrid with one to three florets. It is creamy white with a darker yellow cup.	\$2.00	___
Mite A good cyclamineus hybrid for the show bench.	\$3.00	___
