# Selected Seedlings

- No. 1-35 *Barrii* - white perianth - large flat flaring cup similar to Mrs. Barclay but larger - more deeply scrolled and fluted - clear deep yellow with rim and edges of scroll scarlet - also mottled red some seasons. Out of Barclay evidently. First bloomed in 1935, originally marked X - Extra fine.
- No. 2-35 *Barrii* - bordering on *Incomp.* - white round concave perianth - neither ruffled, fluted or lacinated - even edge - wide band of solid red one half width of cup - no blend of red in rest of cup making contrast in colors sharply distinctive. First bloomed in 1935 - one of seven seedlings out of the *Incomp* "Helios". Originally marked ~~XXX~~.
- No. 3-35 *Incomparabili* - Perfect round overlapping flat perianth with medium length cup - cup and perianth uniform clear dark golden yellow. - superb form on order of Pedestal - First bloom 1935 - Original #7.
- No. 4-36 *Leedsii* - Out of "Her Grace" - white round perianth frilled and fluted trumpet of cream pale yellow with most remarkable double edged deeply lacinated fading early to white. Unlike any other trumpet in collection. (Tentative name "Crinoline lady") Seed x Francis Drake in '35. In digging summer of '36 accidentally pierced bulb with prong of spading fork - No bloom in '37 but small offshoots thrown up - will save bulb.



# Selected Seedlings - Cont.

No. 5- *Barrii* - Large pure white rounded perianth - shallow very pale yellow flattened cup - a tinge of color in edge some seasons - cup turns white - perfect form - better than Melvane (Opened 1925 - was #31-ex)

No. 6- *Barrii* - Large round white perianth - flat gold cup - broad solid red band - perianth - cup center and wide red edge make three concentric clearly contrasting circles - naturally suggesting the name "Bull's Eye" to Ogden - a perfect flower in form, substance and color. 1939 - Particular/ held for days in sun. DeGraeff praised it highly - good - cup splendid - red band tentative name "Target" - asked to use pollen.

No. 7- *Leedsii* - or *Barrii* - but out of Expectation - Pure Poeticus white - frosty - short triple edged fringed chalice like "Expectation" but creamy white or pale lemon with flame red or scarlet fringe. Brilliant against glistening white perianth particularly effective because cup immediately turns creamy white and scarlet intensifies. Very tall. Was best of all the 1935 Seedlings - originally ~~xxx~~ Ex. - but like Expectation was a disappointment in '36 - Splendid in 1927 (1939 - like year before and first year - edge of cup cinnamon to coral red - very dainty.

No. 8- *Barrii* - Lovely snowy white extra large round and overlapping perianth - scarlet edged orange cup - ruffled + fluted (was #252 - first bloom 1937) 35 - Similar to #17 - larger - cup not so scalloped held color well - excellent contrast in colors.



# Selected Seedlings Cont

- No. 9. *Barrii* - Small flower but good form and color - clear yellow round perianth - small open red cup - solid color - crinkled. (\* was \*97-36)
- No. 10. *Leedsii* - White perianth - fair form - trumpet immediately fades to white leaving pink deepening to bright clear real pink. in 1940 - improved in 1941 - 1 large 2 small opens pale yellow with pink ruffled edge - yellow flush half of length of trumpet with edge - Color holds until flower collapses. First opened bulbs planted 1941. Both flower and pollen fertile
- No. 11 *Barrii* - Another fine white "perianthed" *Barrii* - scolloped on order of "Expectation" but flattened white perianth - brilliant red margin to open - Cup double frilled - (red picotee edge) and like Barclay. (was \*245-1937) (1939 - large Expectation flaring frilled cup - a gem.
- No. 12-35 - *Leedsii* - Kingdom seedling - much improved in substance - "waxier and crisper" (Opened 1935 - original #61)

No. 13-36 Finest of 'Leonie' type - much improved - clear deep well ruffled of same color. (Opened in 1935 - was #81)
