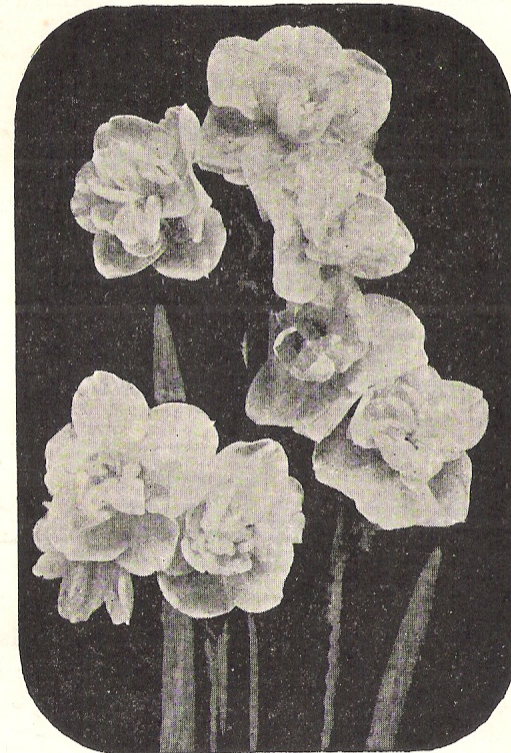

**GIANT YELLOW TRUMPETS (Cup longer than petals)**

E King Alfred—Deep yellow, very popular - - -	\$0.85
L Emperor—An old, well-known variety - - -	0.45
M Olympia—Large trumpet, very fine - - -	0.75
M Lord Wellington—Same colors as King Alfred, but larger	2.50

**BI-COLOR TRUMPETS (Petals white, cup yellow)**

M Aeolus—Very well-formed flower, large - - -	\$0.40
M Van Waveren's Giant—Famous large flower - - -	1.25

**WHITE TRUMPETS**

E Beersheba—Very fine large white - - -	3.50
M Mrs. Krelage—Sometimes called the white King Alfred - - -	1.10

**PINK TRUMPET**

E Mrs. Backhouse—Perianth white, rose-tinted trumpet	4.00

**WHITE-PETALED INCOMPS  
(Cup much shorter than petals)**

M Beat All—Fine, tall, red orange trumpet - - -	1.50
L Bernadino—Orange cup, red frilled edge - - -	0.85
M Damson—Tall, dark crimson cup - - -	1.50
M Francisca Drake—Wide yellow cup, orange edge - - -	0.50
M John Evelyn—Large, beautiful, frilled orange cup - - -	2.00
E R. M. Tobin—Tall, with deep orange cup - - -	1.50

**YELLOW-PETALED INCOMPS**

M Croesus—Deep orange cup, popular - - -	1.00
E Golden Frilled—Beautiful large flower, all yellow - - -	1.10
L Lucinius—Deep yellow crown, lighter petals - - -	1.20
E Helios—Tall, sturdy, wide petals, deep yellow - - -	1.00
M Red Cross—Tall, extra fine, red-orange trumpet - - -	0.40
E Sir Watkin—Old and popular variety, light yellow - - -	0.50
L Yellow Poppy—Well-formed, light yellow - - -	1.30

**WHITE BARRII (Cup 1-3 length of petals)**

M Albatross—Fine, red cup - - -	0.65
L Expectation—Cup yellow, with lacy red edge - - -	1.30
L Firetail—Cup deeper red than any other variety - - -	1.70
M Lady Diana Manners—Red cup, beautiful tall flower - - -	2.50
L Masterpiece—Flat scarlet cup like button - - -	0.50
M Nobility—Tall flower, flat cup edged red - - -	1.10
L Pride of Virginia—Tall and outstanding, orange cup - - -	2.50
L Red Beacon—Crinkled red cup - - -	0.70

**YELLOW-PETALED BARRII**

E Bath's Flame—Wide perianth, orange-edged cup - - -	1.00
M Brightling—Fine, large flat red cup - - -	1.80
L Red Guard—Apricot tonged petals, deeper apricot cup	0.40

**GIANT LEEDSII (White petals, cup white or cream)**

M Her Grace—Beautiful, all white - - -	2.00
M Phyllida—Primrose cup, large - - -	1.20

**SMALL-CUPPED LEEDSII**

L Silver Salver—Green cup, cool-looking - - -	0.50
L St. Olaf—A lovely flower, blooms very late - - -	1.60
M White Lady—Light yellow cup, an old favorite - - -	0.40

**CAMPERNELS & JONQUILS**

E Campernel Regulosus—Deep yellow, two blooms - - -	0.40
M Golden Sceptre—Vary large - - -	0.90
E Orange Queen—A real orange campernel - - -	0.80
M Jonquilla Simplex—Sweet dainty, deep yellow - - -	0.80
L Double Jonquil—Double form of above - - -	1.00

**POETAZ (Cluster of blooms on one stem)**

E La Fiancee—Fine, tall, white petals, orange crown - - -	1.00
L Glorious—White perianth, scarlet cup - - -	1.00
M Laurens Koster—White petals, yellow cups - - -	0.50
M Scarlet Gem—Yellow with red eye, large clusters - - -	1.50
L Cheerfulness—Double, white & cream	1.00

**TRIANDROUS**

M Thalia—3 to 5 flowers on a stem, unusual, white - - -	1.80

**DOUBLE**

L Albo Pleno Odorato—Latest of narcissi, likes shade - - -	0.50
E Campernel Plenus—Double form of the old favorite - - -	0.50
M Daphne—Sweet, like a gardenia - - -	0.50
M Mary Copeland—White with red center - - -	1.50
M Primrose Phoenix—Like a large rose - - -	0.90
M Sulphur Phoenix—Like Primrose but cream - - -	0.90
E Twink—Yellow with orange center - - -	2.00

**FOR ROCK GARDENS (Dwarf types)**

E Bulbocodium Conspicuum—Six inches tall - - -	1.20
M Glitter—Deep yellow, eight inches - - -	1.00
L Gracilis—Fragrant, yellow - - -	1.40
E William Goldring—Small early white trumpet - - -	2.00

**POETICUS**

M Horace—Attractive flower, long stem - - -	0.75
E Ornatus—Earliest poeticus, white, red eye - - -	0.40
L Recurvus—Very late, white, red eye - - -	0.40
M Thelma—Large flower, white, red eye - - -	1.00

**FOR NATURALIZING**

	Per bushel
20-Variety mixture, giving long season of bloom -----	\$10.00
6-Variety mixture, bloom throughout season -----	7.00
