Dear Roberta - You exhibited a seedling once FairyCircle X Minuet.

I am doing an article on F.H.Chapman who raised Minuet and it seems I may have to hang my tale on Minuet as there is so little information about him as a person. Powell used Minuet in Crosses, Wm.Jackson regarded it very highly in crosses. It is mentioned as being in B.Y. Morrison's garden; Daffodil Mart listed it; Mrs. Pratt used it in a "stream" of daffodils at Little England. It is the only poet cultivar by Chapman that we in the poet Round Robins have. Can you tell me if it proved to be a success for you and where you got it - also do you know any tidbits about Chapman that do not appear in 1914 or 1933-1971 RHS Yearbooks? It is my earnest hope, as you know, that constant mention of poets particularly this series of articles about their raisers will revive interest in the division and help the daffodil world by saving them from extinction.




