

- TRIANDRUS PULCHELLUS**, a very beautiful little daffodil with elegant clusters of flowers with primrose perianth and creamy white cup, ht. 9".
- TRIANDRUS QUEEN OF SPAIN**, a wild hybrid. The flowers vary slightly in size, and sometimes in form of trumpet, but all are a uniform, delicate creamy-yellow, with graceful reflexing perianth, ht. 12".
- W. P. MILNER**, a charming free-flowering variety, with dainty sulphur-coloured flowers, one of the best varieties for pots and for growing in fibre in bowls. A. M. R. H. S.
