





Yielding a brilliant, multiplying profusion of flowers for years on end in fields, woods and gardens, Narcissi tolerate a wide range of sunlight from full sun to semi-shade. They do, however, prefer well-draining soil, hate "wet feet" and love to be fed with bulb fertilizer three times a year. Cater to these needs, and you will be repaid with an ever-growing display of glorious flowers for both outdoor and indoor delight!

TRUMPET DAFFODILS

APRIL-FLOWERING. PACKED AND PRICED PER 100.

The most well-known group of Narcissi, Trumpet Daffodils naturalize well and have a long blooming season with large, bold flowers. Their flowers have trumpets as long as, or longer than, the flower petals. 18" to 20".



DOUBLE NARCISSI

APRIL-FLOWERING. PACKED AND PRICED PER 100.

Resembling Camellias and small Peonies, these flamboyant Narcissi have multiple layers of petals or crowns and are great for the garden and arrangements. 16".

Cheerfulness: Beautiful clusters of double creamy white flowers per stem.

Meeting: Superb, all-yellow flowers as large as Peonies. (8260) \$45.75

JONQUILLA NARCISSI

A vigorous, freely-flowering strain sometimes called "Polyanthus Narcissi", each bulb bears four to eight clustered flowers on multiple stems. Very fragrant! Ideal for southern areas and good further north with a little winter protection.

Cragford: Large clusters of fragrant blooms with a white perianth and a striking orange cup. Later-flowering. 18". (8081) \$39.75

Minnow: A miniature, white beauty with a yellow cup bearing four to five clustered flowers per stem. Great for rockgardens! 18". (8264) \$21.75

TRIANDRUS NARCISSI

APRIL-FLOWERING. PACKED AND PRICED PER 100.

These graceful Narcissi produce several drooping flowers per stem amidst slender foliage and a light, aromatic scent. They naturalize well in semi-shady areas.

Hawera: A little gem with four to six pendulous lemon-yellow flowers per stem. Very fragrant. Great for rockgardens! 10". (8176) \$23.75



APRIL-FLOWERING. PACKED AND PRICED PER 100.

The small, dainty flowers of the Species Miniatures represent many varieties of Narcissi as they were originally found in the wild hundreds of years ago. These nursery-grown species need some protection from freezing and thawing.


- Angel's Tears:** Also known as *Triandrus Albus*. Clusters of creamy-white flowers with a reflexing perianth. Great for rockgardens! 7". (8016) \$30.25
- Canaliculatus:** A delicate miniature with a white, slightly reflexing perianth and a globular yellow cup with three to four flowers per stem and several stems per bulb. Great for rockgardens! 6". (8048) \$29.50
- Gracilis:** Three to five flowers per stem with a clear yellow perianth and a tiny, yellow-green cup with a deeper yellow corona. Late-flowering. 10". See *Narcissi Novelties*, page 18.
- Yellow Hoop Petticoat:** Also known as *Bulbocodium Conspicuum*, this true miniature is golden yellow and shaped like a petticoat! Great for rockgardens. Very early. 6". (8496) \$29.75
